

Pino's Good Ciao!

I know Santa Barbara is more than a hop, skip and jump away from Sicily, but this lack of authentic Italian is very frustrating. I mean, I'm a guy who likes my tomato sauce with real tomato taste, and my meatballs had better be chock full of meat. That's a simple request, I think. Fresh, delicious Ita-lian food. What I usually get around here, though, is reconstituted, reprocessed and simply revolting. It's like Chef Boyardee had infiltrated the local eateries and replaced the pasta with Spaghetti-Os.

Now, I only eat at Pino's. And the great part is, they don't get sick of seeing my face at 5:00 p.m. every day for my late lunch and then again at 8:00 p.m. for my late dinner. If this place was open in the morning, I'd be there too, ordering my late means Tasty Food Place With Cloth Napkins. And Italiano is just a reminder that you won't find any sushi or couscous on this menu.

What you will find is Santa Barbara's answer to mama's kitchen back in Italy, only without the steamed windows and stained aprons. Pino's offers its customers their choice of pastas, from traditional spaghetti and linguine to delicious rigatoni and mani-cotti. And there's more than just sausage and meatballs to top your pasta, too (unless, of course, you are like me and think that large chunks of meat on top of spaghetti and tomato sauce creates the perfect meal). If you want a real taste of Ita-liano, try the ham and egg based sauce over your riga-


A Pino's specialty — in addition to the food on the daily chalk board menu labeled "Specials" -- is a dish known as gnocchi. An intriguing name indeed, and I'm still not sure about the pronunciation. But you don't have to say it to eat it. That's a good thing, because gnocchi (pronounced either Naw-Kee or Knaugh-Key) is a potato dumpling dish whose taste is quite a pleasant surprise to those of us who were raised on a strict Italian diet of pasta.




