Season with salt & fresh-ground pepper.

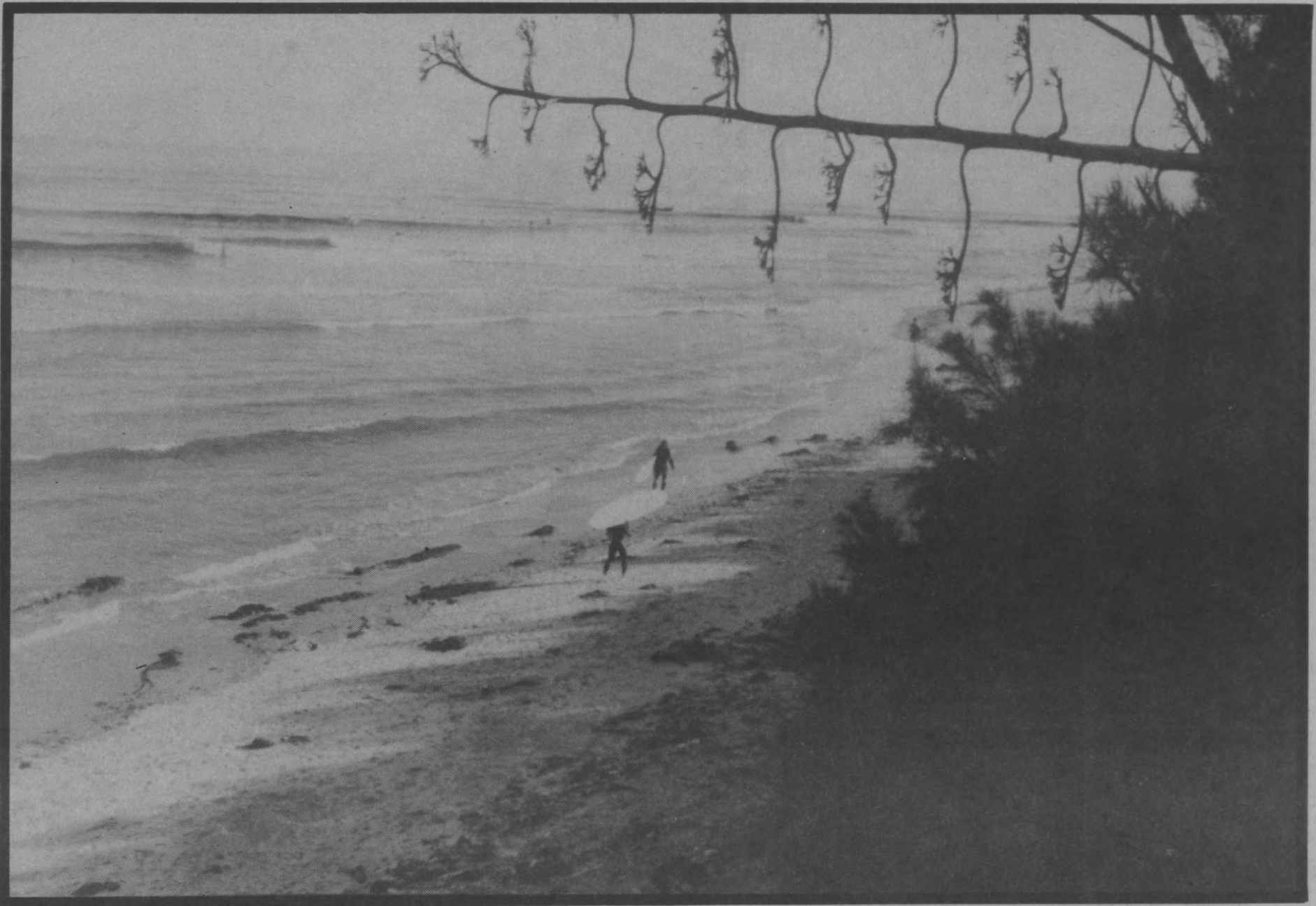
