PEPE'S IS THE PLACE

It's easy to sometimes get a little tired of typical happy-hour knick-knacks and Lakers games broadcasted simultaneously on six wide-screen T.V.'s, with KTYD classic rock blaring out of 1000-watt speakers and hundreds of boisterous customers crowding around a busy bar.

For a more sedate, romantic dining experience, where a couple or a group can sit down for a moderately priced Mexican dinner and conduct a conversation without even once screaming to be heard over the din, Pepe Delgado's Mexican Restaurant presents an attractive alternative.

Located in the heart of Goleta at 254 Orange Avenue, Pepe's subdued environment oozes tradition. Last year, the restaurant even received a "Goleta Beautiful Award" for its striking architecture.

And it was well-deserved. When you first walk into

Pepe's, you immediately notice the striking artwork, the unusual archway-windows, the papier-mache parrots swinging on perches hanging from the ceiling and the smell of fresh salsa. And perhaps you'll see the smile on the face of your waiter or waitress.

What more could you possibly want? A little music, a little ambiance, and a little friendly service seems to cover just about everything. Oh, I know. You might want some food. You'd be in luck. Fortunately, Pepe's offers a veritable smorgasbord, with an extensive menus and daily specials, all reasonably priced.

You can attempt to choose between 32 entrees, a la carte burritos, flautas, carne asada, shrimp smothered in garlic and "probably the best chili verdes you can get anywhere around here," as one friendly hostess put it. It ain't easy.

But perhaps more im-

portantly than the food itself, the tortilla chips alone are reason enough to make a trip to Pepe's. Hot, fresh, and primed for taking a huge dip o' salsa or a mound o' guacamole. If you're not stuffed by the time the main course comes around, you'd have to be master of self-control.

For the *piece de resistance*, a companion of mine recommends the chicken flautas, laden with cheese, spices and chock full of chicken. Myself, I'd have to suggest the chorizo con

huevos, a combination of eggs, Mexican sausage, rice and beans which can be rolled into a couple of massive burrito with the help of conveniently placed flour or corn tortillas.

And the menu also offers a host of domestic and imported lagers, margaritas, wines and other thirst quenchers, like a Mexican hot chocolate. The ample food and drink might prove to be the perfect companion to the Mexican trio which appears every Friday night.



THE BEACHSIDE

Eating in Isla Vista sometimes gets a little repetitive. But just a hop, skip and a jump from town is an oasis escape from the pizza hum-drudger and chopstick mania. Beachside Bar/Cafe has proven a consistent haven for those wishing to pamper the palate on a good piece of steak or a fine selection of fresh seafood.

Located adjacent to the pier on Goleta Beach, the cafe is a favorite choice for business diners, late lunchers and first-time daters. Along with good food and free popcorn, the restaurant is best known for its picturesque day and nighttime views of the ocean and surrounding landscape.

Especially cozy is the patio, particularly if the weather holds up.

The menu runs the gamut from lobster to snapper, teriyaki chicken to top sirloin. Dinner entrees range in price from \$8 to \$26 and come complete with piping hot sourdough rolls and a choice between soup and salad.

And let's talk about that selection for a moment. Either a tomato based hearty shrimp soup or a creamy New England clam chowder is offered nightly. And if a whole meal is too much, you can feast on a Chowder Boat, an edible sourdough bowl filled with the chunky and delicious

soup. And if you're not a chowder head, either a Caesar's salad or a nice tossed plate o' greens will be delivered to your table.

Recently, during a heavy business dinner, my associate and I dined on some of their choice selections.

I succumbed to one of the nightly house specials, a grilled New Zealand Lamb with a mint sauce on the side and my companion lost herself amid the fillet and lobster plate.

Tender and tasty is the best way to describe the treats that were served that night.

The lamb was juicy and prepared to perfection. And, while this is not a regularly

offered selection, it attests to the quality of the various specials that are offered on a revolving basis.

The pricy Australian lobster tail was equally tasty. A healthy portion graces the plate offering the shell fish lover a char-broiled bonanza of butter-soaked nirvana.

Complementing the seafood is a fillet capable of turning the staunch vegetarian into a cannibal.

Needless to say, a doggie bag was needed to cart home the leftovers.

To get to this hot spot, take the Sandspit Road exit and turn left into the Goleta Beach Parking lot.

Cattlemen's is a target that should be placed high on your hit list of local eateries.

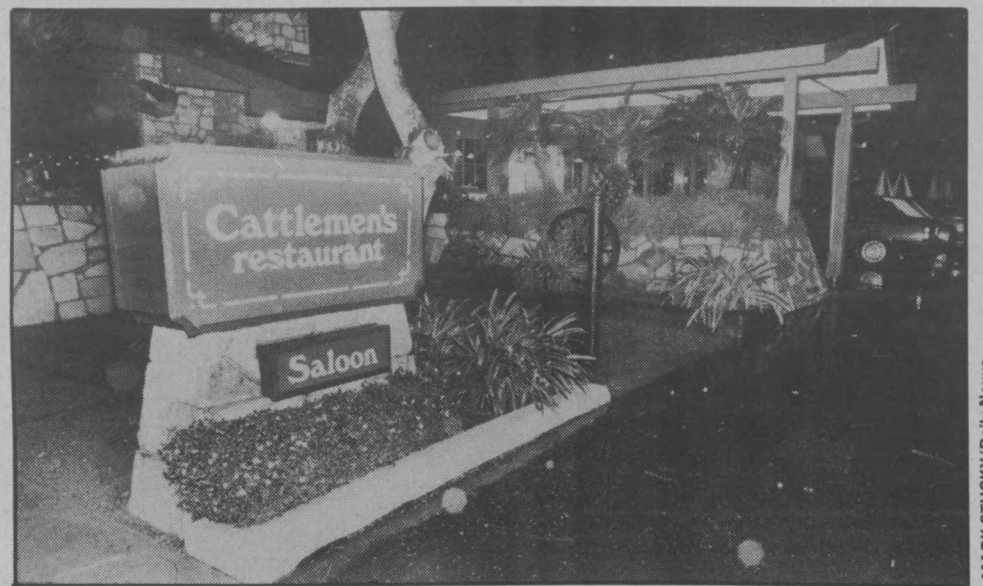
Featuring a wide assortment of seafood, poultry, and beef, the restaurant has come a long way since it changed ownership more than a year ago.

For seafood lovers, the blackened red snapper is simply a marvelous pick. Ask your waiter or waitress about their recommendations and you'll find they are happy to help. Prices span the scale from lows to highs, but you'll find a meal to accommodate your appetite. Whether you need a quick and light lunch or a full spread dinner, you are not likely to leave unsatisfied.


A nice arrangement of munchies is always available, ranging from chips and salsa to egg rolls, enchiladas, ribs and chicken.



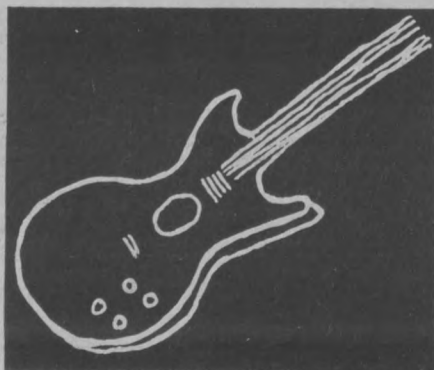
