

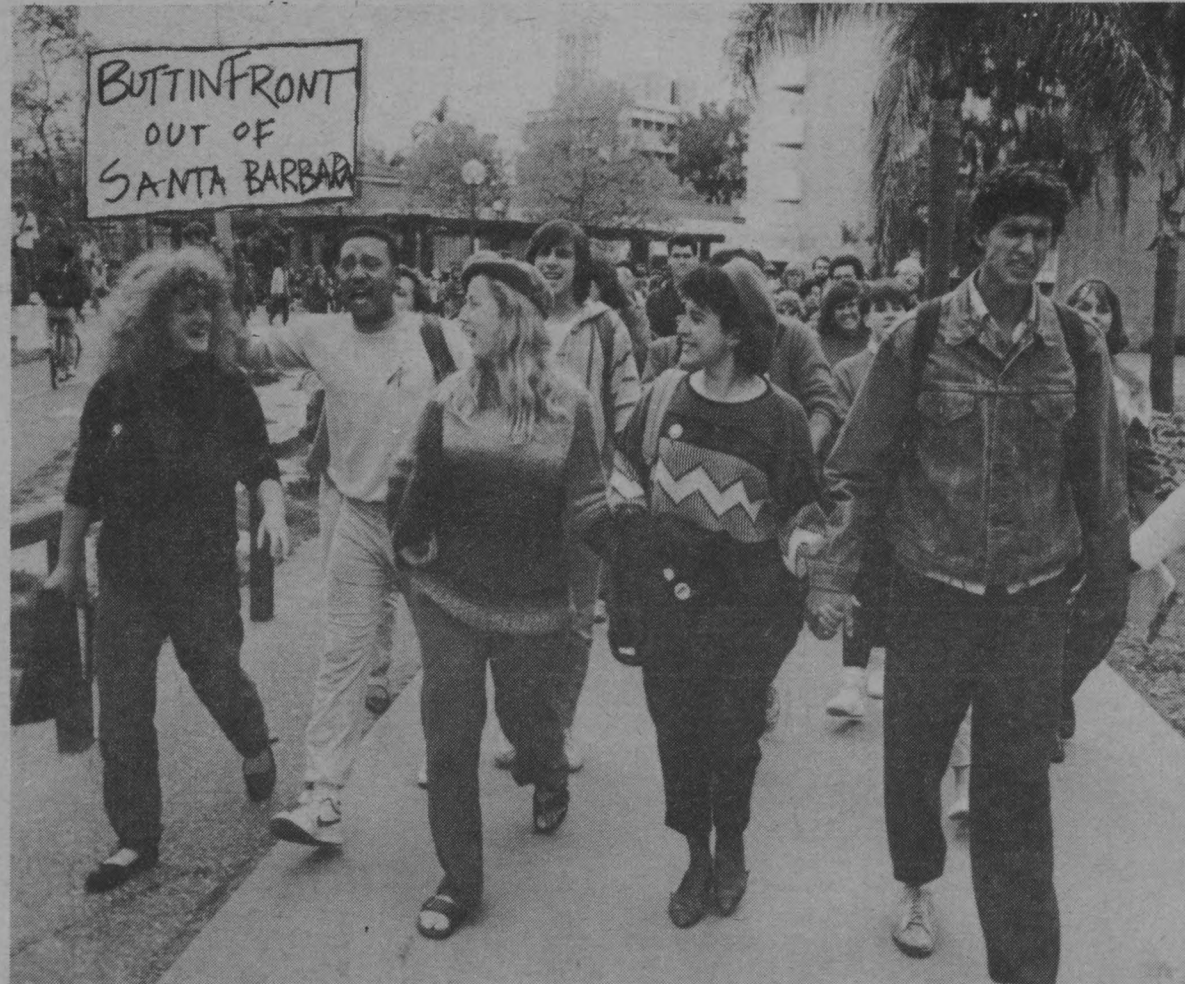

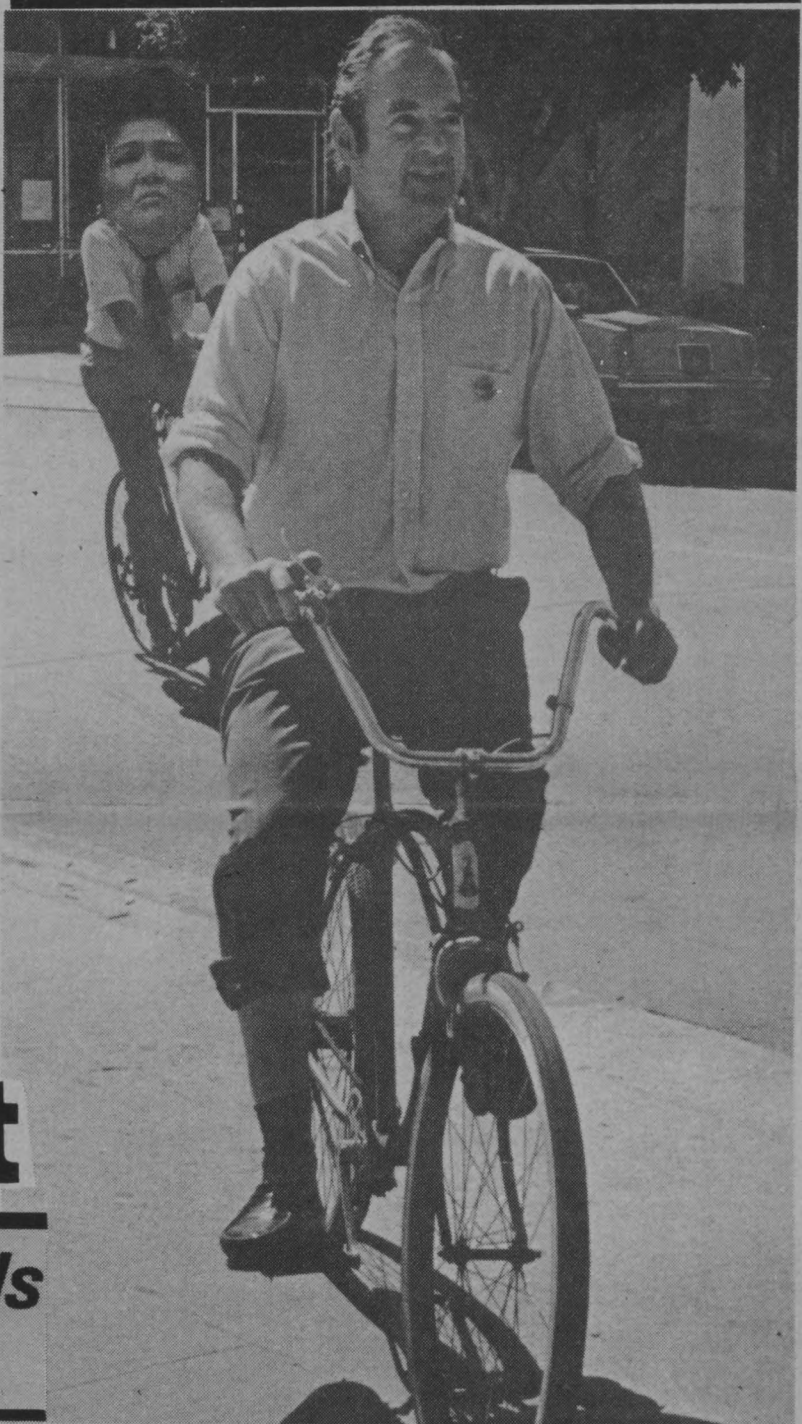

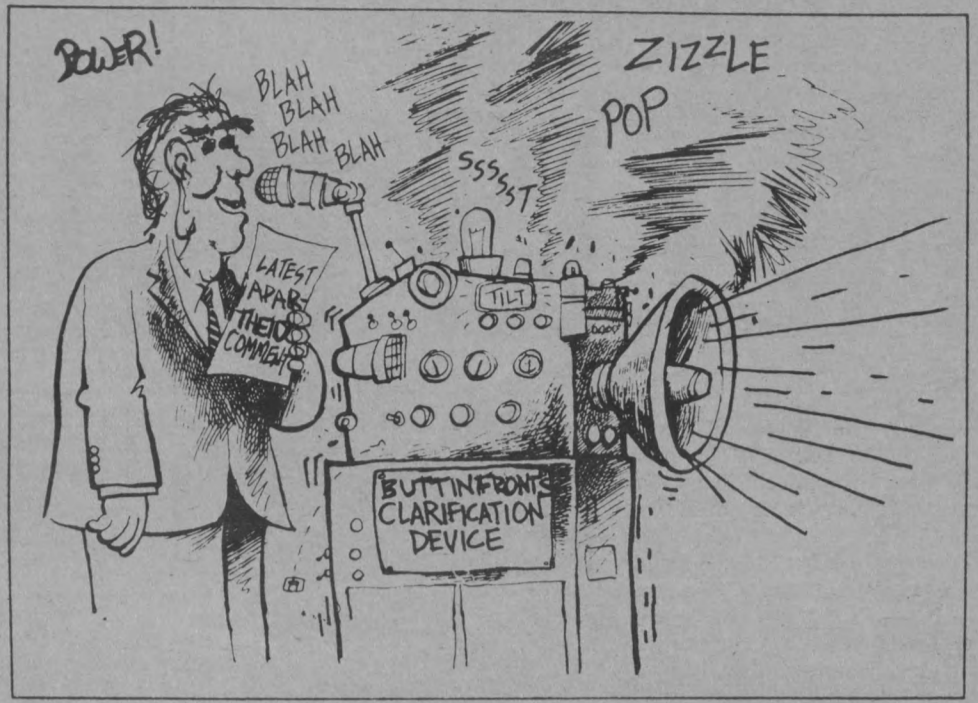

Students were revolting yesterday, as two former administration officials led a ragtag band of protesters to Chancellor-for-life Bob Buttinfront's spacious office, permanently ousting the unpopular and verminous dictator.

"It's been a long time coming," said Raymond Voyeur, formerly Buttinfront's second-in-command and now a prominent opposition agitator. "Nobody liked him. He was scum."

Protesters followed commands from Assinine Students President Ken Greenpeace, who has headed the opposition party since the late Slim Dickman lost favor, due to what his political buddies are calling a Buttinfront plot. Dickman also served as A.S. president until that "plot" made students think he took their money and he resigned and got a small fine from Buttinfront.

New evidence, among that which sparked the successful revolt, indicates that Buttinfront and his wife Imelda probably used the students' money to finance a trip to Italy earlier this year. The A.S. Vegetative Council has long led opposition to Buttinfront's oppressive dictatorship, as well as to his wife Imelda.

"Well, I'm not really sure what to say," Greenpeace said after taking office as UCSB's new chancellor. "I would like to examine the issue, but I'll do what the students and A.S. Executive Director Margarita Hash tell me to do."

The coup was also aided by Acting Vice Chancellor Bob Cruisemissle, who with the help of the Facilities Management Office, provided keys to Buttinfront's office and locked out the campus Stormtroopers (Buttinfront's private bodyguards). Facilities Management employees said they were tired of Imelda's constant phonecalls requesting them to clean up around her Montecito Mansion, called Mywhatawaste.

According to these employees, Buttinfront's main squeeze demands they mop and wax "and even do the bloody windows."

According to Greenpeace, this aid was extremely valuable. He continued, visibly shaken by the drama. "I just wish Slim was here to enjoy this, and I wish we could have caught that rascal Bob."

Dickman was found dead Monday afternoon from what administration members are calling spontaneous combustion. There are rumors that he was not in fact consumed by

internal flames, but subjected to a Buttinfront letterbomb at his fraternity house. Federal officials already engaged in an investigation of the fraternity system may uncover an explanation for the bizarre incident.

As for Buttinfront, he and wife Imelda fled the campus on their two-wheeled cruisers. Imelda looks like a man (see photo). They met a waiting helicopter at the Santa Barbara Municipal Airport, which jetted them to a hideout in Berkeley, near the Useless College's central offices.

Reporters near the scene say they the felonious funlovers absconded millions in campus "Campaign for UCSB" funds, basing the information on a comment Imelda made to her hapless hubby. "Now we only have a limited budget, what will I do for a wardrobe?" she is reported as saying.

Meanwhile, UC President David Pardonner said the two will have sanctuary until they can find a peaceful home. So far, in one night, they have charged \$50,000 at the Berkeley campus student store and students there have asked that they make their new home on Alcatraz Island, which would be donated for the purpose.

Pardonner said he recognized the new chancellorship, but didn't know how the regents would take it. They still support Bob.

Back at UCSB, Assinine Students has created an internal audit

committee to look into banks where Buttinfront may have stashed his loot. Much of it is reportedly in the South African Savings and Loan, an institution which awarded the former chancellor-for-life a board seat.

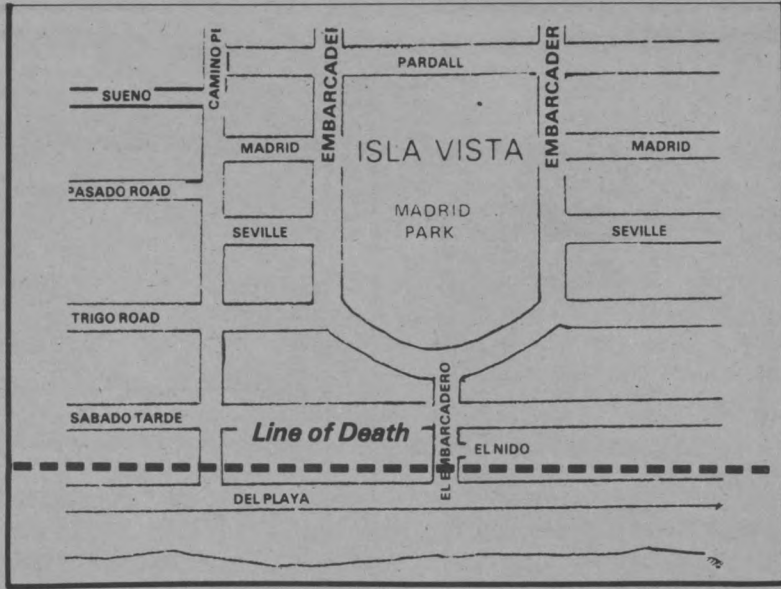

**Terrorists Enclose D.P. in 'Line of Death'**

Members of the Drunk People's Liberation Organization, a local terrorist group, have drawn a "Line of Death" around Del Playa Drive in Isla Vista to keep unwanted residents and disrespectful visitors off their claimed territory.

Non-Del Playa residents who cross the fatal line, as well as any residents who are rumored to have parked their cars in the driveway of neighboring apartment complexes will be attacked by bomb-throwing DPLO members and hidden snipers, and will be subject to kidnapping, said DPLO Spoketerrorist Dee Struction.

"We have sealed off the area to foreign imperialists because we are sick and tired of American students invading our property," Struction said. "Anyone who dares to cross our 'Line of Death' will suffer because we plan to retaliate violently," she added.

The DPLO's "Line of Death" extends from the 6500 block near the UCSB campus to the end of Del Playa, and all property in between these boundaries has been declared off limits to outsiders. A three-mile offshore limit of the Pacific Ocean from Campus Point to Coal Oil Point is also included in the "Line of Death."

The DPLO's decision to draw a controversial "Line of

Death" around Del Playa came after some members committed violent acts against illegally parked cars and vehicles parked in residents' driveways.

"People who park in my driveway or parking lot are asking for it. We are only defending our rights to our territory," DPLO member and UCSB senior Abu Nidal said.

Several targeted automobiles were completely destroyed by bombs and the car owners physically tortured by the DPLO to end what DPLO members call "provocation" by non-Del Playa residents. At least two dozen other cars sustained severe damage such as broken windows and slashed tires, said Sgt. Yawn Hurd of the Isla Vista Stormtroopers.

The stories told by those who have crossed the line are grim. "I was parking my car in a friend's parking lot behind his building and all of a sudden three masked gunmen ran up behind me and grabbed me. They tied up my hands and feet, beat me up, and threw me into a shed where they left me without food or water for six days," a DPLO terrorist victim who wished to remain anonymous told the *Daily Campus News* in an exclusive interview.

"When the kidnapers let me go, I went to get my car and it was gone. The next day I got a call from the I.V. (See DPLO, p.7)

# Assinine Students Elections To Mean Nothing, Again

UCSB will bask in the democratic process later this month as Assinine Students readies itself for the 1986-87 elections where voters will decide on worthless issues including an annulment of a confidence poll for Chancellor Bob Buttinfront.

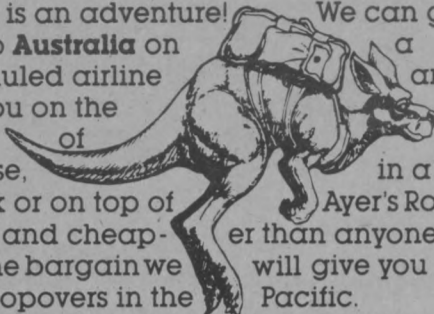
E called Bates a commie burn-out. "The man is crazier than a Libyan patrol boat commander. He swears up and down he has chats with Marx and Stalin daily."

Elections will be held April 21-23, unless they are cancelled for lack of interest.

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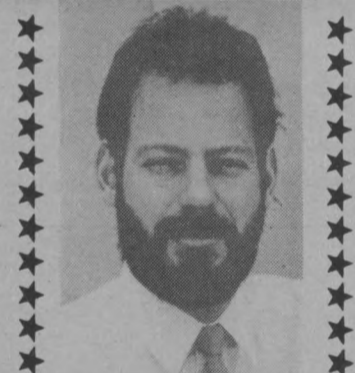

# San Diego Mayor Turns Pink Over Red Invasion

Dumbfounded Republicans around the country rejoiced at the fulfillment of Ray-gun's prophecy.

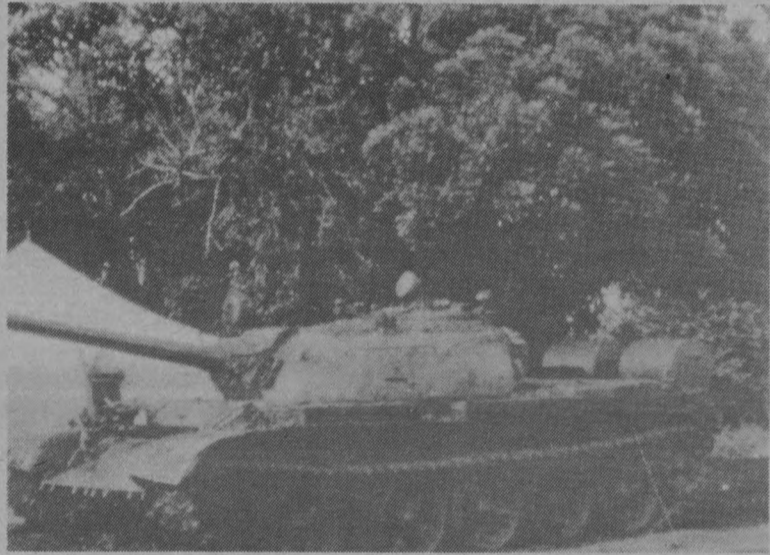
"I told you! I told you!" Ray-gun stated emphatically from his Santa Barbara ranch, restating his premonition that "the red wave would soon be lapping at our shores."

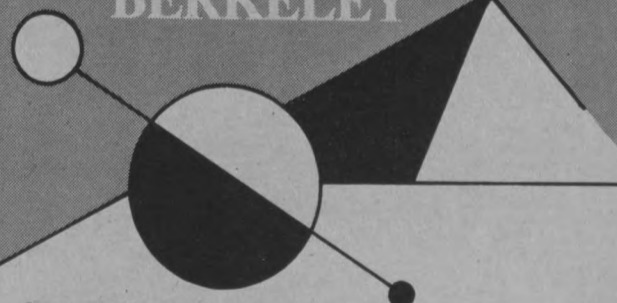

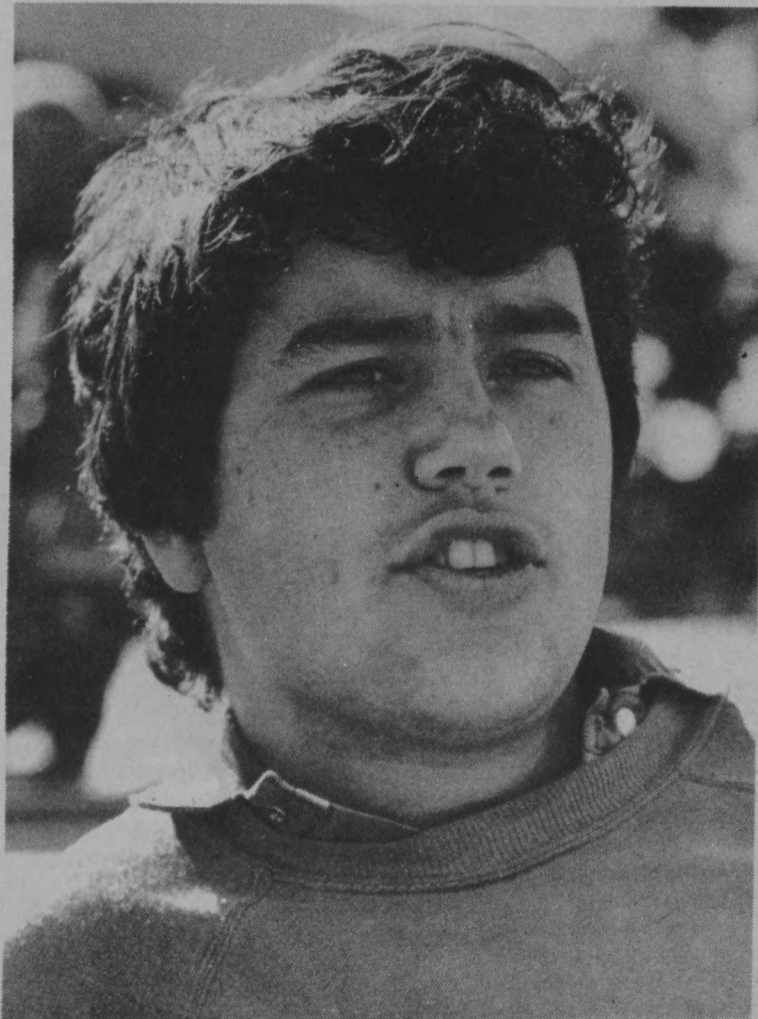
Social and physical scientists have wondered for years how such a large number of malignant

Funeral services will be held this Thursday at Santa Barbara Rent-A-Plot, Inc. Greenpeace refused an invitation to speak at the ceremony and claimed, "I'd really love to make a speech about Slim, but I just can't make up my mind about what I want to say."

An after-funeral reception and party will be given by Smith and External Vice President Rich Lame in the A.S. office.

# Students Discovered Buried in Reg. Line

In a startling discovery, archeological crews, commissioned to excavate the lagoon for the long rumored remains of the administration's credibility, uncovered instead 769 perfectly preserved UCSB undergraduates with reg cards and schedule adjustment appointments in hand.

"They may not have gotten any

classes, but I don't understand why they had to stick around and be so obstinate about it," Buttinfront said. "Students are always screaming for classes and a place to live. The crybabies. I'll show them."

Burp assured Veg Council

members at their last meeting that registration will run smoothly this quarter. "I can't see any students being lost in the lagoon again," he said. "But you never know what sort of computer malfunctions can oc-

cur."

Assinine Students President Ken Greenpeace said he would like to say something about the incident, but he just didn't know what. "I'll do what everybody wants though," he added.

## Art Imitates Life; Stallone Appointed Peace Envoy to C. America

Larry Speakes announced today at a White House news conference that Sylvester Stallone, known to millions of Americans for his portrayal of movie characters Rocky and Rambo, will be appointed by Reagan as the new peace envoy to Central America.

Crispin later related to the press that Mrs. Reagan was heavily addicted to valium and Peppermint Schnapps.

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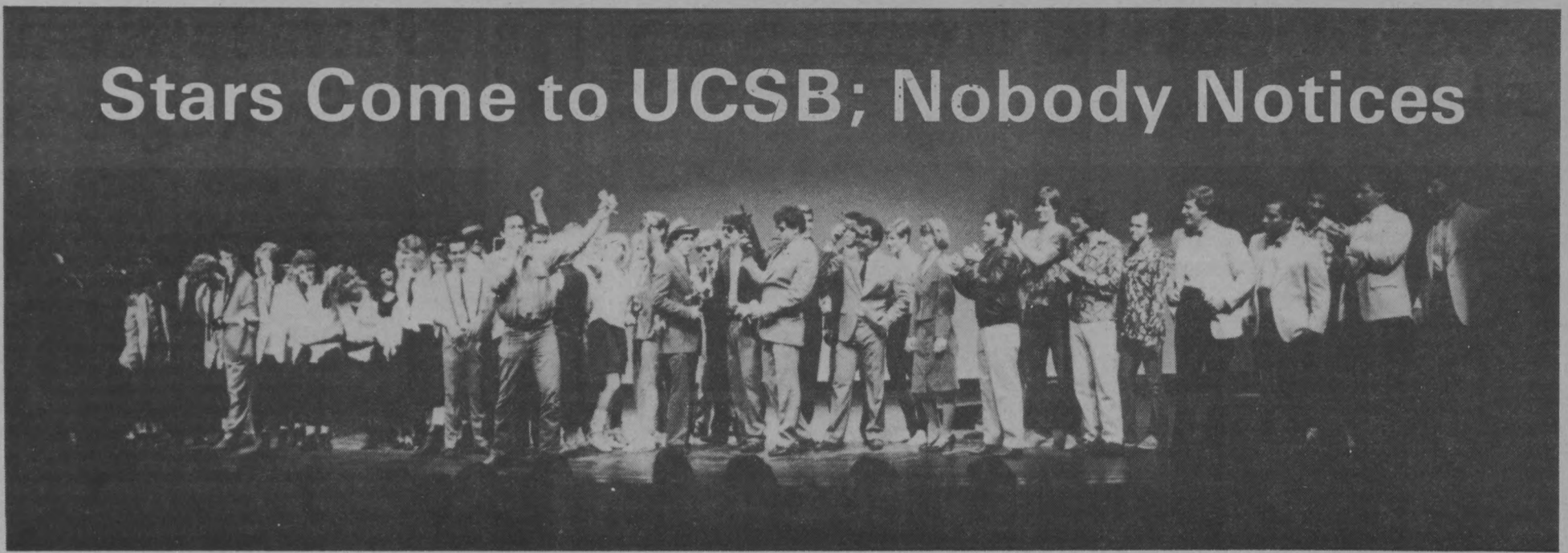


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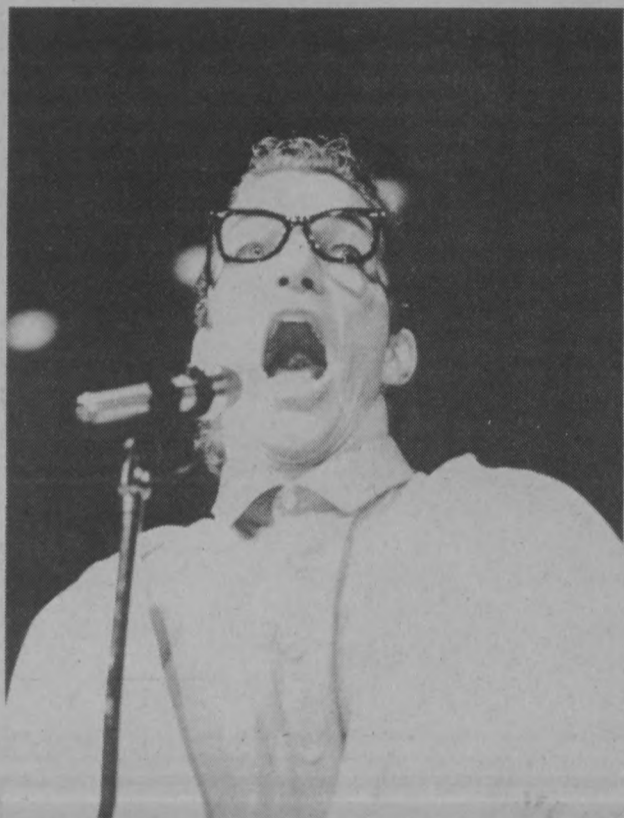

# "Toxic Mtn." Park Opens July 4

Following months of public speculation on the future of the Thatsmellia toxic waste site, Thatsmellia Resources owner Bargain Hunter said at a news conference Monday at the Goleta Pilot Inn Convention Center that he would make the site into an amusement park.

The next step came when UNLV beat Memphis State in Vegas. Starting to get the picture?

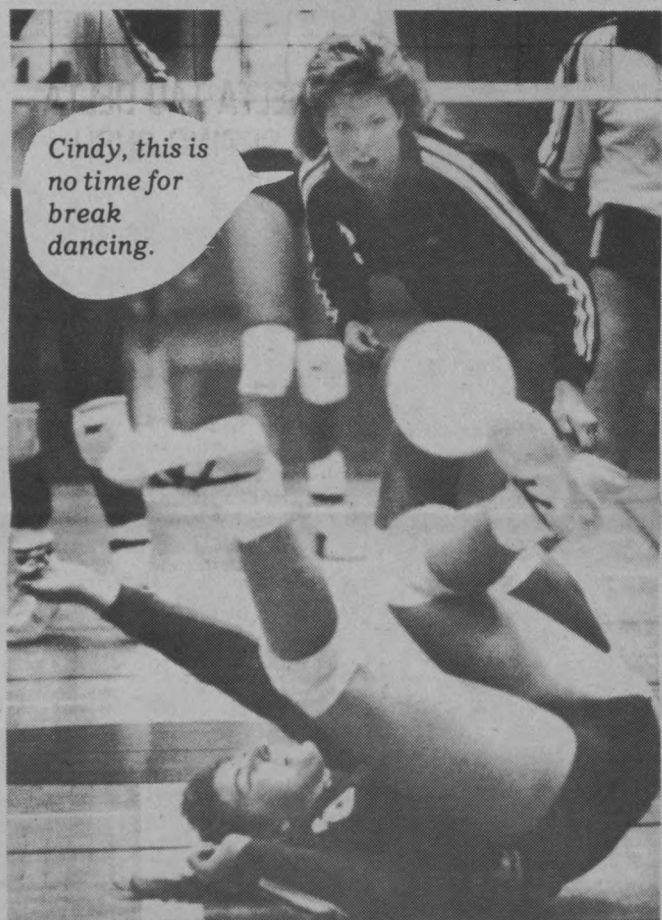
If you recall, Louisville lost only seven games this season. One of those losses came at the hands of none other than the Tigers of Memphis State.
