ZELO HAS GOT IT ALL

It isn't often that a restaurant/night club is able to successfully combine the best aspects of both enterprises into a single cohesive unit.

Whether the food is treated as an afterthought to the ambiance or the haute cuisine is so haute that eating it is no fun, something usually goes wrong.

Not so at Zelo.

Dining at Zelo is not just a simple culinary adventure. It is a total sensual experience. From the modern kinetic art lining the brick walls, to the red laser pulsating the length of the dining room, to the techno-pop music emanating from the dance floor, a trip to Zelo is a trip.

If classified, the food at Zelo would likely fall in the category of modern cuisine. Which does not mean that you get a tablespoon of entree, a piece of parsley and a decoratively chopped carrot stick. The portions are generous, and as this eater can attest, two meals can easily be split between three people.

But to go straight into the main course would be a

waste, if it meant skipping Zelo's appetizers. The things they can do with sweet potatoes might amaze you, and you're sure to be pleasantly surprised by their sweet potato chips. Also, give the egg rolls a whirl. With hot mustard and raspberry dipping sauces, they offer dueling and complimentary tastes.

On most nights, Zelo offers a number of fish dishes. The Idaho trout in pecan sauce is a taste you're not likely to find at too many other restaurants in the area and the accompanying steamed vegetables are crisp and colorful.

Perhaps best of all, however, are Zelo's legendary pasta dishes. I must admit that when I first read the description of the mustard chicken fettucini I was a bit skeptical. The last time I had chicken fettucini in Santa Barbara I thought I had been given a vegetarian dish. The pieces of chicken were so few and far between that what was there I had mistaken for finely minced pieces of mushroom.

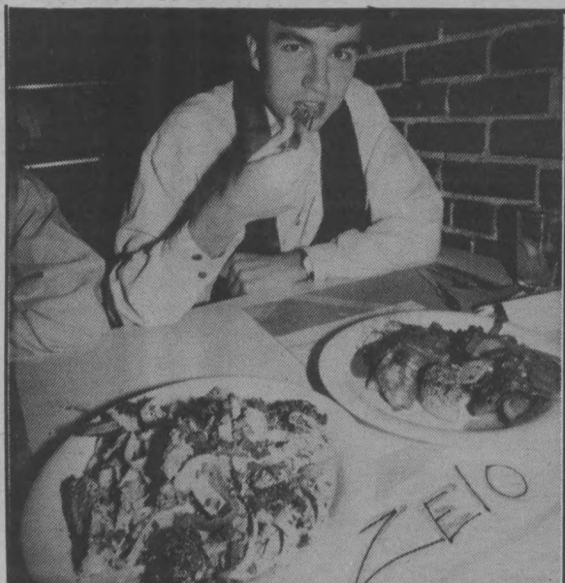
At Zelo, however, the chicken is cut into long

breaded strips, and practically covers the pasta. Now that's chicken!

As most fine restaurants do, Zelo offers a variety of beer and wines. Though the prices range from the low to the very high, with a bottle of Dom Perignon '80 going for more than I make in a month, a good glass of wine or beer can be had for a reasonable price.

So check it out. You might be surprised. That hole-in-the-wall teeny-bopper dance

club that you always ignored also happens to be a place for some serious eating and serious fun. Zelo takes reservations and on a weekend night it's probably a good idea to make them as the place fills up fast and people like to hang out there even when they're done eating. Afterall, there's no better way to burn off a good meal than with a couple of hours of good dancing. Have fun and bon appetite.

The Blue Dolphin Cafe has so much to offer — and so early in the morning, too! Having breakfast in a room with a soothing blue sealife atmosphere or on their outdoor patio is the only good reason to wake up Saturday morning. But I think everyone else in Isla Vista has the same idea. Guaranteed, it will be packed before you get there, but the wait ain't too long and it's well worth it.

They have a fabulous selection of omelettes and other breakfast delights — all at really great prices (You gotta try their wheat pancakes and fresh juice). And service comes from such familiar faces as your friend's old roommate or your neighbor.

Watching the dogs frolic under the trees (or under your table), eating good

But wait, it gets even better. They serve really good espresso drinks and until the end of the month, they are half price. Look out Roma,

the atmosphere may not be the same but that doesn't mean it's not just as good.

Or soon to be better — the management is currently trying to get live music at night. Finally, a place for people to go who enjoyed part of what Borsodi's

Coffeehouse had to offer.

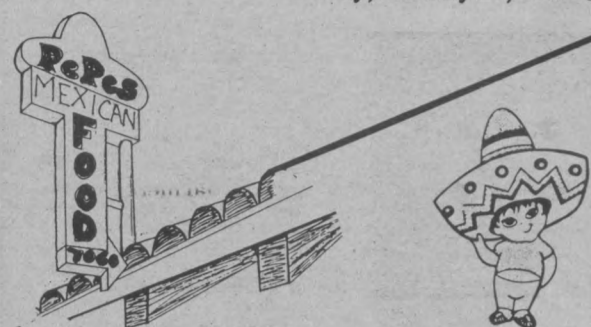
