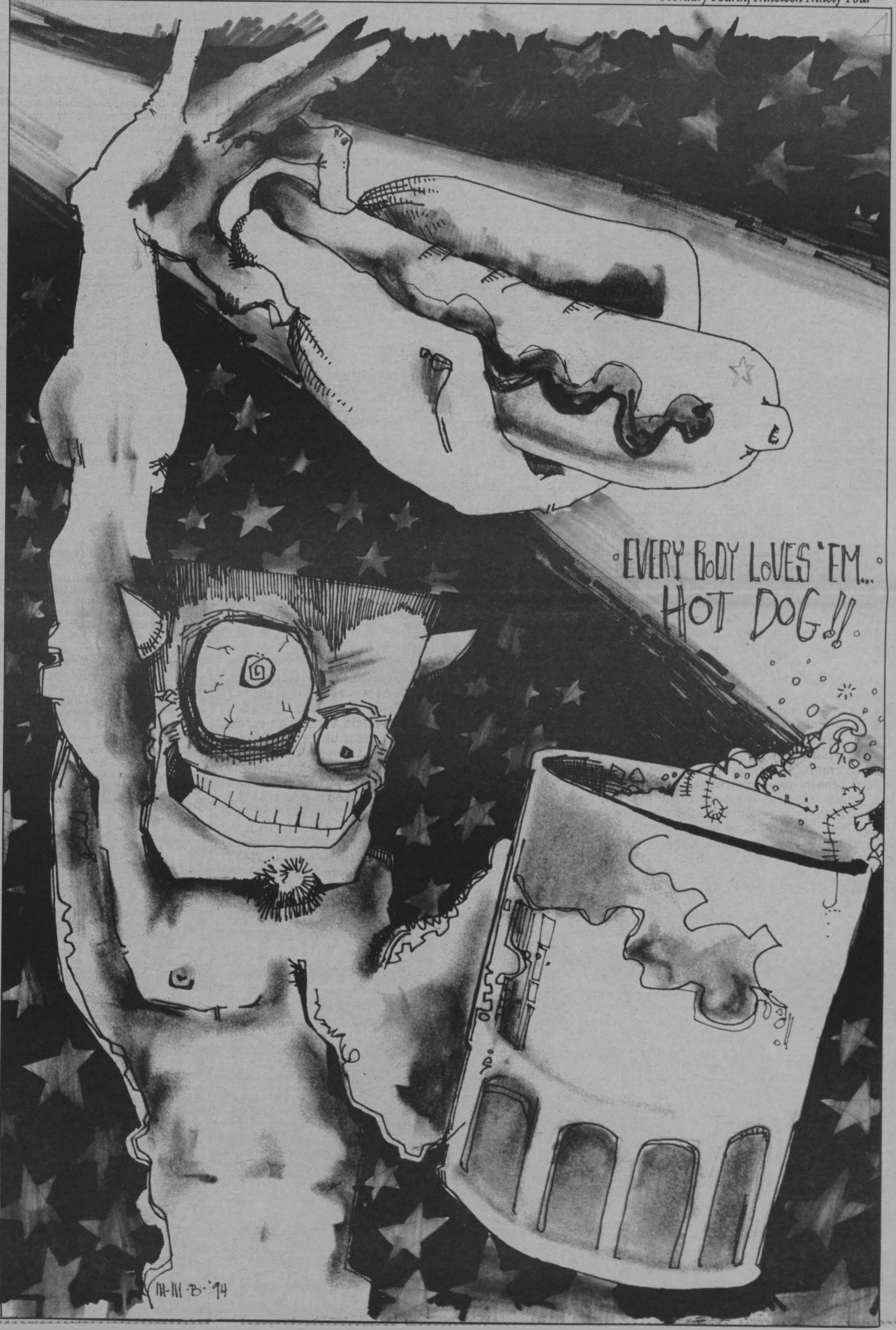

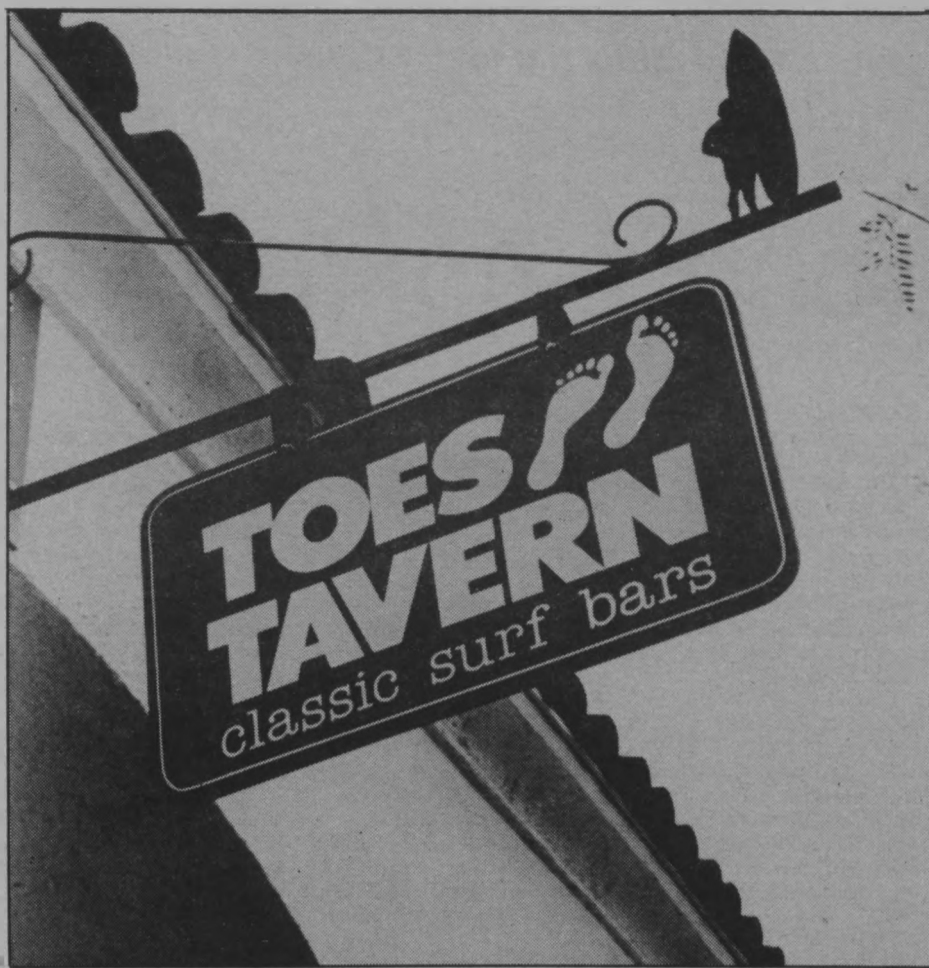

Suppose you were asked to review *Star Wars*. What would you say? People who have seen it will not need your opinion, they've probably seen it many times and have enjoyed it enough to buy the action figure of "Walrus Man" or "R5-D4" or any of those characters who were on screen for less than five minutes but still got their own immortality in molded plastic.

People who haven't seen it, well, what could you tell them?

OK, maybe the phrase "classic surf bar" doesn't float your boat. Maybe you like your beer consumption to take place in a darkened room surrounded by lost souls. Maybe you need a change of pace, buddy.

So go to Toe's Tavern this weekend. You'll be glad you did. Remember Luke, the force will be with you, always.



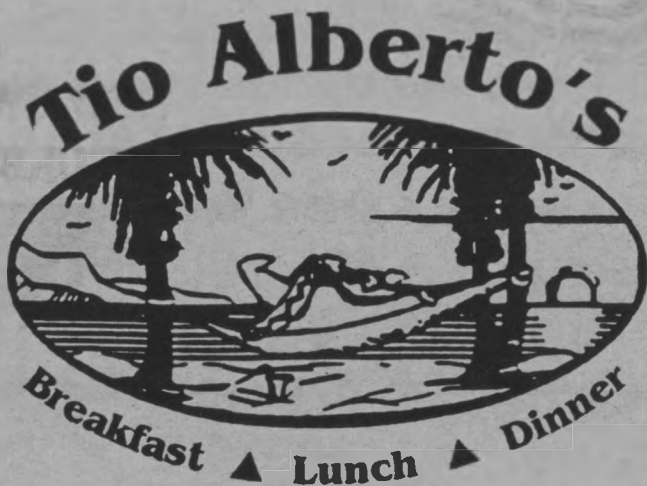

He recommended to my friend a tasty dish filled with coconut rice (unusual), pieces of mahi mahi, mussels, shrimp and vegetables. The dinner was piled high on Christina's plate. Thinking she'd definitely have leftovers, she instead ate the whole thing along with her garlic bread and salad.

This Polynesian paradise has salads, stir-fry, kabobs, chow mein, the Hawaiian burritos, soups and sandwiches all under \$6 (with exception to Christina's delicious dish). They even have pupus. Isn't that a great name? Pupu. It's so much better than simply saying appetizers.

For those who get bored with their dinner companions, despise making conversation or just enjoy sports and games, Maikai can please all your needs. There is a large TV, which was airing a hockey game, a pinball machine and a chess and checker set. It's just that kind of place. You could go and hang out with a couple of friends to watch the game and eat a couple of pupus and drink some beers, have a concentrated game of chess in the corner or go solo with the pinball machine.

But the food is the best. Their chicken kabob was delicious. Just over \$5, the plate was covered with brown rice, a nice salad and two skewers filled with chicken, zucchini and onions. And for vegetarians, they have plenty

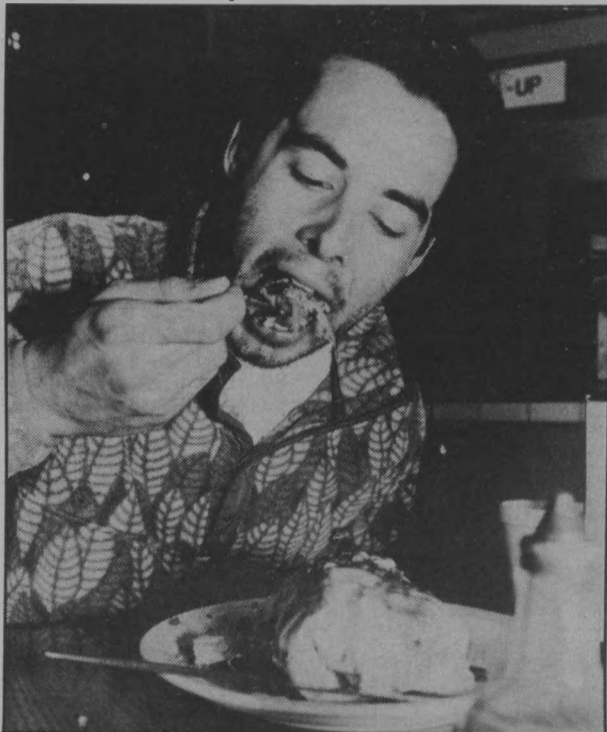
of Polynesian goodies to offer: tiki salad, stir-fry vegetables and the Oahu Burrito.

They also cater to any meat lovers out there. Jack had a juicy teriyaki steak which he devoured quickly.

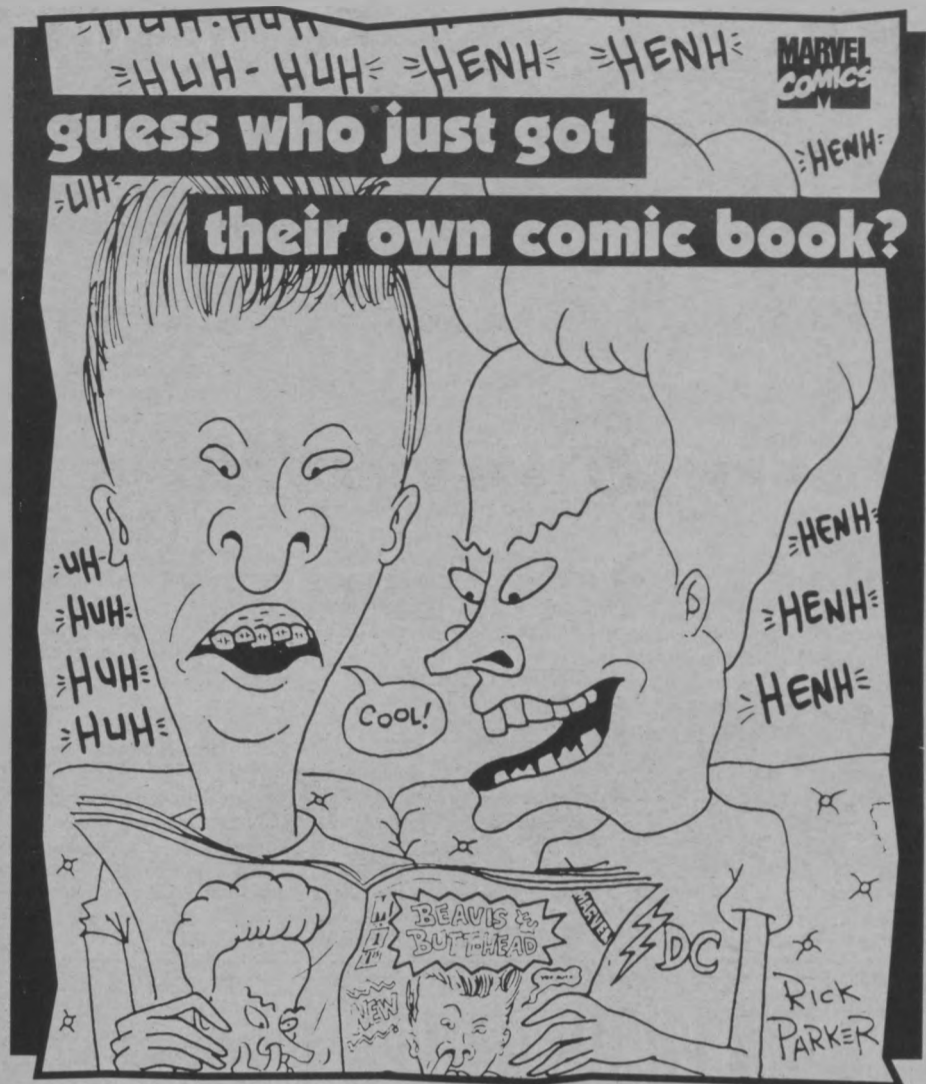
If anyone is in the mood for something different, try a piece of Polynesian paradise. Maikai has more than great food. They have

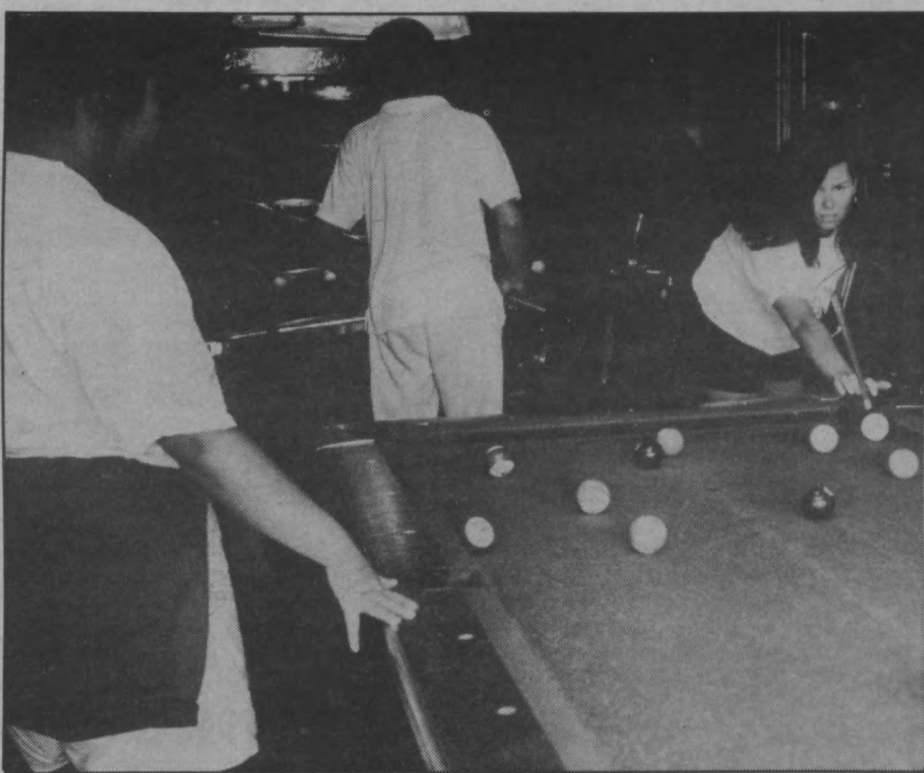
Anyway, we set off, armed only with the knowledge that it was on Kellogg Avenue in Goleta

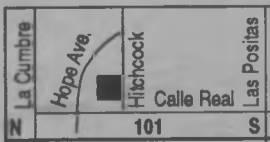

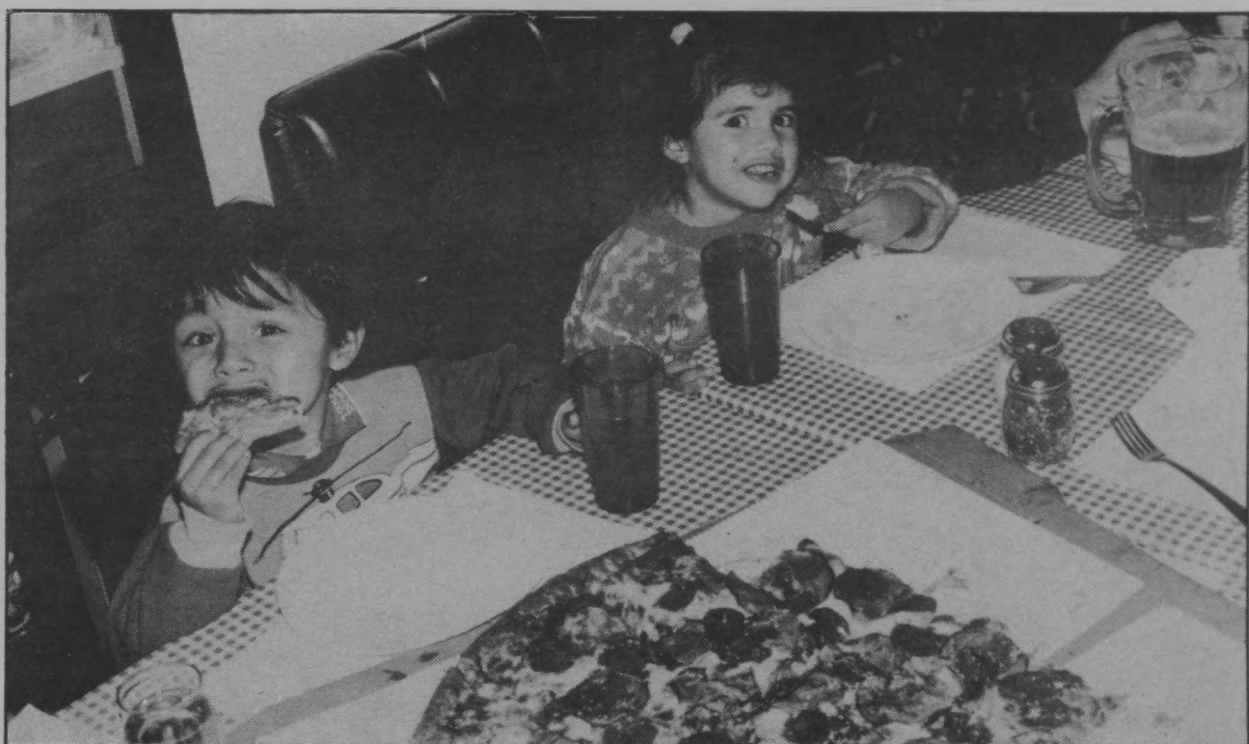

It all started with the bread. Funny, I've heard a lot of restaurant conversions start off this way. A glowing, almost angelic waitress with flowing

brown hair brought it to us in a red basket, loaded with mozzarella and garlic.

It could only be described as an eye-opening, revelationesque bread. We had asked for chicken parmigiana and spaghetti with meatballs, I with a meat sauce for the chicken parmigiana's side of pasta. How could we possibly expect such generosity? Wasn't a restaurant only beheld to supply their customers with what had been ordered?

It was at this time that Mortimer saw the light. He nearly fainted. What dizzied Mortimer so was the second plate of bread. In fact, now that I think back, it may have been the smell that really touched Morty's soul.

Earth can but feign attempt to match the smell

of a fresh-from-the-oven loaf of Luigi's homemade garlic bread. It must have been heaven-baked and no doubt the hand of God had buttered this loaf. While Mortimer recovered, I polished off a full three-quarters of the Italian manna.

Then it was my turn to see stars. With a wisp of her dark seraphic hair, our angel appeared out of Luigi's kitchen gates in an apron and nurse's comfy shoes. Hoisted delicately in her arms was a large, flat tray, carrying what I first thought were two powerful flashlights, turned on full blast.

Somewhere, something like music could be heard. Somewhere else, much closer, angelic voices sent up hosannas to the chef. I

turned, and there was Mortimer, singing full-throated praises to "those who do God's work on the hearth."

A soft, comforting and reassuring voice said, "Your chicken parmigiana, sir," and I turned to see what could only be described as a platter of breaded chicken parmigiana and spaghetti with meat sauce in an unearthly and nearly blinding light.

If I hadn't already been sitting, I probably would have fell to my knees. As it was, I slumped with religious conviction. I hardly dared bite such a thing of beauty. It seemed that a short prayer was in order.

"Oh, Lord of all things culinary, I thank thee for thine heavy graces. Let this, thine glowing

chicken parmigiana and that, thine holiest of holy spaghetti with meatballs, be delicious and fulfill us up with thy spirit. Amen."

Morty was finished. Completely. Every last drop of meat sauce, every slip of spaghetti. I'm not really sure what happened next, but I think I did some very, very passionate eating followed by what was described to me by Morty as "singing, dancing and howling at the gates to the kitchen." So sayeth Morty, so demandeth Luigi's food.
