Alex's: Superb Mexican

Some people live to eat, and after experiencing Alex's Cantina, I can almost see why. That ultra-satisfying feeling of fullness achieved by eating delicious food is one of the great pleasures in life. And at Alex's Cantina, they do you up right.

My roommate Max and I went last week at his urging. He had gone the week before and talked endlessly about Alex's famous tortilla maker that manufactures fresh flour tortillas right before the patrons' astonished eyes. He said they had great food and an incredible happy hour, too. Under the condition that he would finally stop talking about it and let me get on with my life, we gathered a few friends and headed down Hollister to Goleta and Alex's Cantina.

Ever try to park on Hollister at dinner time? Better that you should try to stop the sun from shining, my young friend! Not at Alex's though. One quick turn and

BAM! ample parking. If you park in the back, you get to walk through the bar area where — if you time it right — you can witness hoards — no, throngs! — of college students enjoying Alex's acclaimed and prize-winning happy hour. Indeed, in this very paper, Alex's Cantina won Best Happy Hour in last year's Best of UCSB section. Who knows what's in store for Alex's in this year's competition? Not I!

Let me try to explain this happy hour to you. Drinks, of course. And vegetables of notable variety, sports on the television where they belong, and this miniature taco factory where you can get tacos that you wouldn't believe. I can't think of a happy hour that offers tacos, and I extend that challenge to you as well!

Anyway, one of the great things about Alex's is their happy hour, but truth be known, it is in the kitchen that these guys get busy.

We were comfortably seated in the dining area proper and instructed to peruse, peruse, peruse their menu. And peruse we did! That

menu is huge — authored, one would suspect, by someone with the culinary prolificacy of Herman Melville — and that's large! I'm trying to say that the menu is diverse and appealing.

If you think I'm talking about an Enchilada Suizas that would make Ben Vereen get right up and do a samba, then you'd be right! If you think I'm talking about a house specialty Chile Colorado that would give Sylvia Plath reason to live, then you'd be right! If you think I'm talking about a Vegetarian Tostada that would make Señor Wences walk into the bathroom and re-grout the tile, then guess what? You'd be right! The food is great.

Luckily, there were four of us: Max, his hairdresser, Henry-Henry and myself. This enabled us to order the Fajitas Family Platter. This dish is meant to impress not only the diner who orders it, but also to impress everyone else in the restaurant. It starts out ordinary enough with some chips and salsa to whet your appetite. Then the waitperson nonchalantly brings out some

freshly made tortillas followed by four side dishes filled with rice, beans, lettuce, onions, sour cream and guacamole. A meal in itself, some would say. But then they bring out the big guns. The waitperson carries out a huge, sizzZZling platter of chicken and beef fajitas and puts it on your table. It sizzles and steams and sizzles and steams — it's like being in a fajita sauna! Everyone in the restaurant eyed us with envy.

And was it delicious? Yes! More food than any of us could eat and we sat there looking like weird men, our stomachs bulging with culinary nicety. It was all I could do to keep awake enough to pay the diminutive bill. It was one of those great feelings of stuffedness; one achieved only by food that you know is wholesome, fresh and, of course, delicious.

We sang all the way home.

It was an especially good conversation, one we wouldn't soon forget, as we

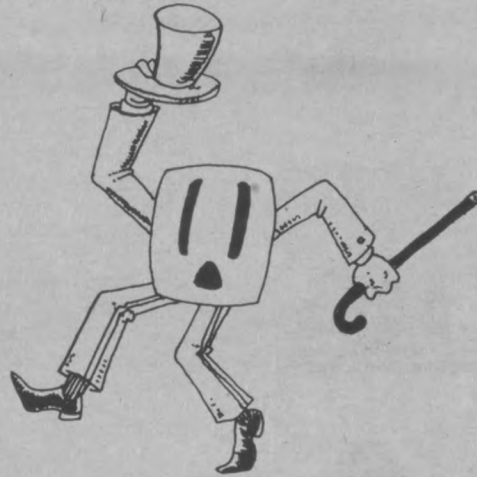


Here is some chicken doing the mesquite grill thing at El Pollo Norteno.

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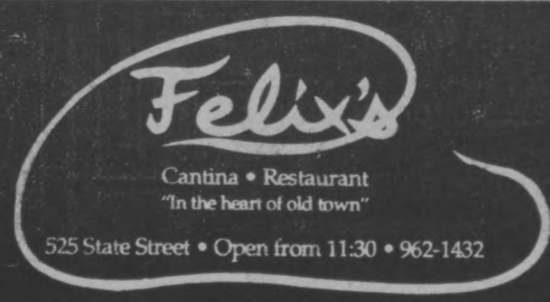

Tired of commonplace restaurants? Had just about your fill of pizza, hamburgers, tacos and sandwiches every day? Would you be depressed if you realized that this is what you are going to eat every day of your life until you die? Well, then be depressed no longer!

Caribbean Cuisine, located locally in nearby Goleta, has the cure for your common culinary lament.

The food is like none you could find in the tri-county area. In fact, you'd be hard pressed to find anything as exotic and delicious as this Caribbean Cuisine anywhere within a day's drive.

One of their specialties is the Fried Plantain appetizer. This is some weird fried bananas with some yogurt-like dip. I wouldn't be able to explain this taste sensation if you rubbed me with croutons until I had a rash, labelled me a cynic and then smothered me in tobasco sauce. For all intents and purposes, suffice it to say that it was warm, delicious, strange and a must-try when you visit Caribbean Cuisine. It really sets you up for the meal you are about to have.

I don't think people know the true meaning of the word "entree" until they go to Caribbean Cuisine. Everything from the Sauteed Halibut to the Curry Chicken to the Mild Teriyaki Steak is so huge! And they don't let you off easy with just that. They fill your plate with side vegetables grande and some delicious rice and peas, which

they refer to on their menu as "rice 'n' peas."

After we were seated in the cozy restaurant, coffees and waters given to everyone, we took a good look around. It was hard to believe that this restaurant turns into a nightclub every so often. They feature some great live reggae bands. The nightclub scene at Caribbean Cuisine (hey! that rhymes!) is one of the most popular aspects of the restaurant.

Indeed, even as we were deciding what to order, the cool and easy sounds of reggae filled the restaurant most pleasantly. I don't know who it was singing, but they did reggae versions of "Maniac" from the *Flashdance* soundtrack and "Sara" by Starship much to our amusement and enjoyment. What a neat place!

My dining companion, Max, decided to be gutsy and get the Curry Shrimp. It was a bold move because it was one of the entrees with an asterisk by it, which meant that it was extra spicy. My taste buds being relatively unaccustomed to Caribbean cuisine in general (plus the fact — and I'll admit it now — that I was somewhat scared that it might be a little too spicy!), I chose the Mild Jamaican Teriyaki Chicken.

Then we sat back, enjoyed our salads and fried plantain and discussed the activities of the day.

When the food arrived, we were speechless. It was all I could do to ask for more coffee! But ask I did, and we set our goals on devouring the plates of food before us.

rice 'n' peas circled the generous portions of meat. Although I was entirely enthralled by my chicken, I was a little depressed that I hadn't had the nerve to order one of the spicy dishes. One taste of Max's shrimp let me know that the Caribbean Cuisine doesn't spice to excess, only to perfection. Spurred on by the great tasting entrees, Max and I ate and ate until our stomachs

held up the white flag of surrender and we knew we could eat no more.

Except for maybe a little desert!

To end the evening on a super note, we got the Jamaican Yogurt, done up right with just a taste of rum. It was delicious.

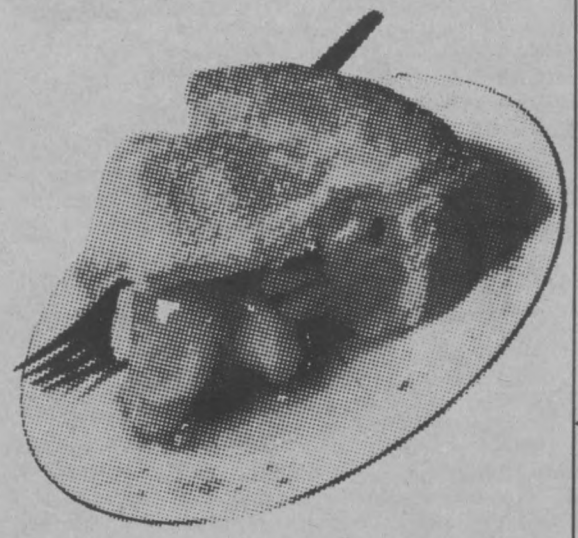
So if you're looking for a little change of pace that is right in step with the college
