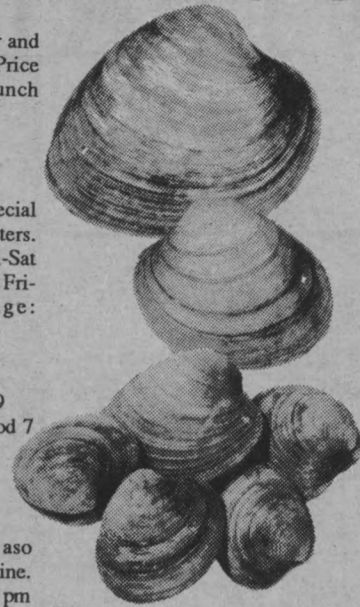

You can also eat steaks and fish that are snappy.

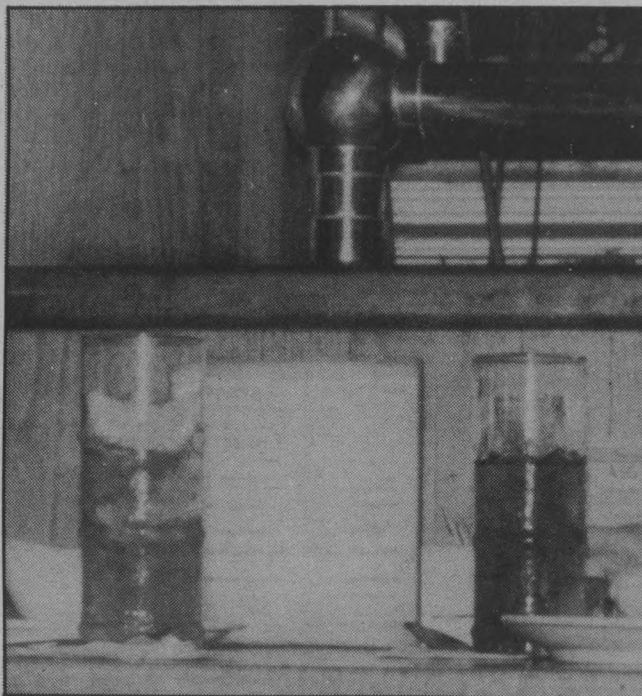
My friend and I visited one winter's eve.

# Chinese Food? New Yen Ching

Because Thai, Ethiopian, Vietnamese and nouvelle South-Western cuisines have achieved a stranglehold on the hip young diner market, Chinese restaurants have been backed into a corner, servicing the needs of an aging crowd who thought Mandarin spices exotic back when they were in their oh-so-heady experimental years.

But faced with this new challenge a few bold Chinese restaurants have decided to take fate into their own hands and recapture John Q. Public's imagination. Foremost amongst these in the Tri-Counties may well be the New Yen Ching at 615 State Street.

From the name alone we can see the innovative thinking happening here: every town in America has a Yen Ching restaurant but only State Street has a *New Yen Ching*. But things don't stop there, oh no. The New Yen Ching has a new pseudo baroque art deco interior in diner green and fuchsia which will knock the proverbial socks offa ya. Etched glass and big cozy booths make this a prime place to take your "Love Connection" date.

But wait! We haven't even got to the food yet! The best things at the New Yen Ching seem to be seafood oriented. The Kung-Pao Shrimp we had was solid and chock full of meaty prawns. The King Crab Sautéed with Black Bean Sauce is a good splurge at \$11.95 and the Abalone with Sea Cucumber is for the truly post-modern. Did you know the Sea Cucumber turns itself completely inside out as a part of its digestive process? How self-

reflexive.

While the New Yen Ching seems to specialize in grandiose specials like Shark's Fin Soup with Crabmeat (Shark Fins are a notorious aphrodisiac so don't overdo it), more affordable appetizers are available and can be pleasantly filling in their own right. Six meaty little pot stickers — "Chinese fried 'raviolies'," according to the menu — go for a right reasonable \$4.95 and could be a meal unto their lil' fried selves.

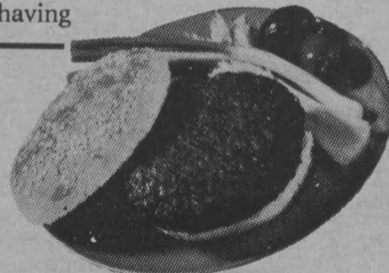
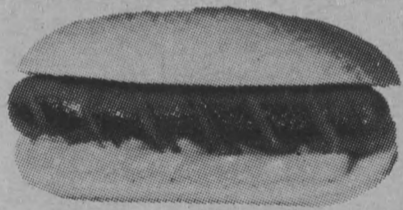
For your social gatherings — intramural team banquets, year end dorm gatherings of joyous togetherness, etc. — the New Yen Ching has a Special Banquet Menu of muni-

ificent proportions. Three price levels are offered — \$8.95, \$10.95, \$14.00 — and each is more glorious than the last. Six or seven entrees are on each, ranging from the traditional Mu-Shu Pork and Sweet and Sour Shrimp through the more obscure Smoked Tea Duck and Dry Braised Lobster and finally coming to rest on the infamous and much feared Tong Ting Shrimp. The myriad bonuses on the Special Banquet Menu include — but don't end at — Three Flavored Sizzling Rice Soup, Teriyaki Beef Stick and the vastly underrated Steamed Rice. Capping off this taste bud tour of the Middle Kingdom are the Cammelized Bananas or Apples, the name having

something to do with going long distances without water.

But don't worry. If you miss the old favorites they're still here. The entire pantheon of mild Cantonese dishes transformed and made famous in America are right here on the back of the New Yen Ching menu, like old friends discovered anew: Chow Mein, Chop Suey and Egg Foo Young. One billion people can't be wrong!

# The Jetty Won't Slow You Down

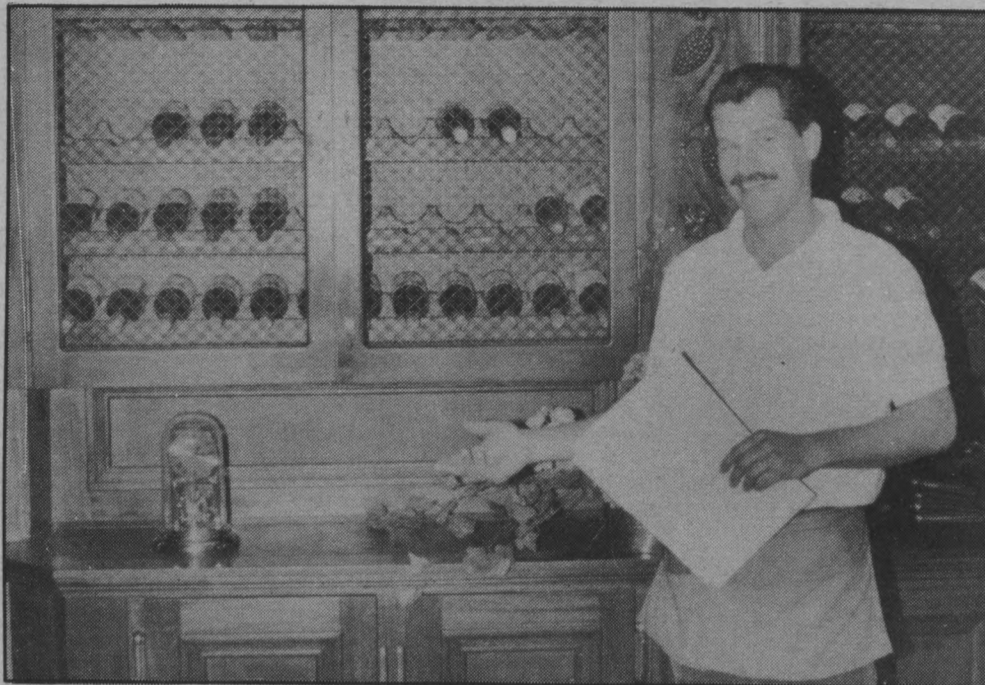

When I think back to my rambles over the emerald isle of Eire, my memory always reverts back to a crusty, weather-beaten ex-sailor I came across one cold, dreary, rainy afternoon in March.

This old chap must've been pushing 70, but from the look of him you would've thought he was ready to cast anchor at first light. We were sitting in a tiny pub, The Three Gaels, a dank hole-in-the-wall (what some of my more "proper" friends might call a dive) and were it not for this retired seaman, I would've been entirely alone. His name was Padraig.

Padraig liked nothing better than to while a day away by a warm fire, a bottle of Bushmills on a table nearby. Through his tales we ventured on travails across oceans. We journeyed to former British colonies in Africa and Asia, and relived naval battles of the Second World War. And naturally through it all I suffered through his descriptions of some of the worst food imaginable. On-deck dining apparently left something to be desired in those days.

"I tell you, I know what it takes for a meal to be a meal. And I'm talking fish, mind you. It has to be fresh. Not yesterday's catch, or God in Heaven Forbid frozen, but living, swimming and kicking just hours before you

bite into it. That's what we always wanted on the liners in years gone," Padraig said.

Looking back on that day's conversation it is hard for me to see how Padraig could have been any closer to the truth. Fresh fish is what really makes me remember a seafood restaurant, and every time I'm in Santa Barbara, there's only one place I think to go for a meal: The Jetty.

The fish is so fresh at The Jetty it would probably bring tears to Padraig's eyes. Last time I dined there, just a few days ago, Grilled Thresher Shark was the Special of the Day, and boy was it fresh! I had it with a teriyakki sauce glaze, re-

commended by the food server/hostess, and it was an excellent complement to the unique flavor shark has. By the way, it was served with a salad and fries, no doubt better than any ship-side food Padraig ever got!

My traveling companion on this latest pass through SB was a bit indecisive about what to sample from The Jetty's fresh fish offerings. "Should I have the Red Snapper Veracruz, with cheese and salsa, south of the border style, or the prawns, or just plain fried fish?" he wondered.

He eventually decided on an open-faced crab melt, a truly California concoction The Jetty has worked up.

just imagine sourdough bread topped with heaping mounds of crab, covered in melted cheese and slivered almonds. Now that's a seafood sandwich!

For those who prefer something other than fish The Jetty can handle that too. The menu is chock full of things like soups and salads and sandwiches and meats and stuff, so you can stuff to your heart's content!

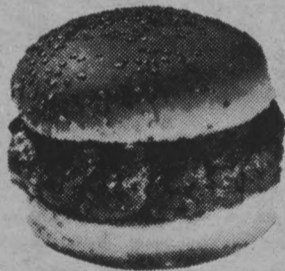

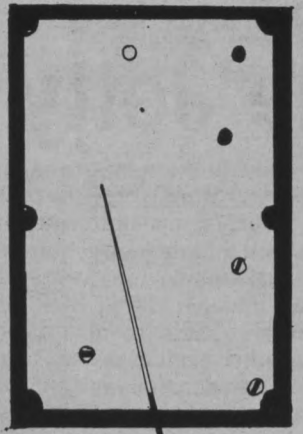
