Parched and hungry, the juices of my stomach roiling for more, I made my way to the State & A one anonymous afternoon and collapsed into a chair out on the patio as a cooling blanket of shade fell across my sorry hide. Quickly, a cool breeze from the street caressed my over-





shrimp, eel, tuna, hokki clam, scallop and smelt egg. Depending on whether a certain fish is in season, the menu may slightly vary, so the fairly wide selection could be ea-sier to choose from. On top of that, the owner and cooks are constantly creating and updating new types of rolls for your pleasure.

A fine recommendation for the first-time sushi-goer is the sampler platter. Featuring various types of raw sushi and a few cooked and tempura pieces along with some fairly tames spider rolls, it allows the diner to taste a wide

range of treats and not leave feeling like it was just an appetizer. The only warning is go mellow on the wasabi and soy sauce — they're pretty strong.

Another thing you'll be sure to be stoked on is the friendly service and prompt order time. But what if you don't have the time to sit and relax and enjoy the meal?

No problem, Far East has take-out. And don't worry, the quality is the same as the dine in and even for the quality is the same as the dine-in and even faster.

So the next time you're in the mood for some quality, authentic sushi, or just want to break away from the four basic food groups and not spend a whole lot. Far East is the definite choice.

# THE PRESS ROOM!



orking at a newspaper requires just three things: talent, hard work and a good place to go for a stiff drink after the hustle and bustle of the office dies down at the end of each day.

I'd like to think I qualify on the first two points, but after a recent voyage to downtown Santa Barbara, I now know where to head to take care of the third—

Recently, after a hard week of interviews and phone calls around the office, my boss asked me to take on a new beat. What I ended up doing I would hardly call work, but my easiest, and most pleasurable, assignment to date.

A few friends came along for the ride (I always ask someone else to drive) as I investigated this quality establishment, located at 15 East Ortega St. —tucked away from the normal State Street action.

The selection at first glance seemed satisfactory. Quality domestic and import ales and stouts were easily available at reasonable prices. The Wild Turkey and Coke I ordered turned up a beverage with a generous mix, light on the cola. That was all fine and good, but we still needed to find the meat of the story. How were their mixed drinks?

We decided to run the usual undercover scheme we use when doing pieces on the local bars. John would pose as a college student out for a night on the town on his 21st birthday, looking for an unusual concoction to cele-

brate with.

The bartender, a British fellow, produced quite an interesting mix, served in a cocktail glass for John. He called it a Santa Barbara Oil Slick, a clear beverage with a slight layer of something darker floating on the surface. I took a taste of it and found a delectable but mysterious mix. John consumed the remaining portion with some gusto to kick-start a night of which he would have little memory the next morning.

But aside from unusual and stiff drinks, The Press Room offered something which one is hard-pressed to find in Santa Barbara bars — an unusual atmosphere. Lining the walls of the bar are front pages of various newspapers, marking the events and happenings that are the highlights of both local

and national history.

Now, while my investigation turned up some impressive findings, I am sad to say that in my search for the truth I overlooked one detail that night. Never did I find out what exactly went into a Santa Barbara Oil Slick. Looks like this may require a follow-up
