





That was the first thing to run through my mind just inside Kyoto's front doors. It wasn't a special date, so a table was more than fine. Oh, it smelled really good,







I've got a new definition for "chuck steak."







When you walk into the Cajun Kitchen, you might think you've happened upon some sort of back-woods bar. Patrons sit around and chat at the bar or at one of the small indoor or outdoor tables. If these unique dishes weren't enough, breakfasts come with your choice of side orders like Cajun Kitchen homefries and biscuits so flaky and buttery that Sara Lee would be jealous. Even the coffee, which is refilled for free, is brewed to perfection. Breakfasts like these are so good you'll get up early to eat them!


