




In thinking of fine Santa Barbara restaurants, most people turn their thoughts toward State Street and the many eating establishments that line the popular thoroughfare. So who could have guessed when we em-barked on the beautiful drive through San Marcos Pass that we would uncover one Santa Barbara's bestkept restaurant secrets: a little place called Cold C Spring Tavern.

We had heard about the food — our friends had seen to that. They couldn't stop raving about it from the last time they had gone. But the food is only part of the experience.

The Tavern is nestled away on a quiet road called Stagecoach, just off of the 154 freeway. Sitting comfortably, nooked in a picturesque forest, it has all the look — and feel — of a quaint mountain cabin. Only John Denver's greatest tunes come to mind as you regard the smoke slowly wafting out of the chimney. And, as they say, where there's smoke, there's good

We were a tad late for our 5 o'clock reservation, but our host was pleasant and seemed glad to seat us anyway. His courteous demeanor was not only a comfort, but it also added to the ambiance. You see, Cold Springs Tavern is warm and softly lit, and despite the chilly and frosty weather outside, you know the restaurant is as toasty as a well-balanced breakfast.

Our friendly waitress was delicious gravy. My mouth

quick to bring us cold water and warm bread with many pats of butter. The two types of freshly baked bread that were brought to us were, in our opinion, the best bread we'd ever tasted. Serious. But, as we were soon to learn, it was only a prelude.

We placed our orders and sat happily, reflecting on the day's happenings. Although the specials for the evening, an unlikely and surprising selection of fresh fish, looked enticing, I opted for the Cold Spring Chicken. I was glad that I did. The chicken and baked potato would be great, I knew, but I could hardly believe my ears when the waitress told me that I also could choose between soup and salad. I chose the soup, an excellent clam chowder.

The chicken came stuffed with a kind of raisin stuffing and covered with a thick,



## Lickity Split: That's Yummy!

Crumbled candy bar experiments were never really a viable option growing up. And the thought of placing pieces of the stuff anywhere near my ice cream or my frozen yogurt was never real popular either.

But now, I've got to admit, it's a good idea. Ice cream has come a long way since I was a child, and Lickity Split — the hippest ice cream joint in Isla Vista — is on the "scooping edge" of ice cream/yogurt technology.

Check it out. They have strange and delicious flavors that sound more like names for bad '60s psychedelic bands than for ice cream. How does "Brazilian Coffee Chip" grab you? Does your Uncle Phil claim he has their first album? Wasn't "Peppermint Stick" a hit song by Strawberry Alarm Clock? I don't know, but I do know this: it's one heck of a yummy ice cream.

When I was younger, things like "frozen yogurt," "toppings" and "smoothies" were just phrases you weren't allowed to say in mixed company. Now they're all the rage. And Lickity Split's got them all

got them all. My childhood friend, Che, came to visit last week. We were reliving some of the good times on our way home from the basketball court, when I reminded him that he had lost four out of seven games and had to flip the bill for some "sceeba" our boyhood code word for ice cream. We walked along Pardall Road in Isla Vista looking for a place and happened upon Lickity Split a sort of airy, avant-garde ice cream shop that likes to do it up with neon while packing its menu with a plethora of ice cream and frozen yogurt goodies. We were awe-struck at first, because the places we'd always gone to when we were growing up on the farm in Minnesota only had your basic three, as far as flavors,

and maybe — maybe — you could get out of there with a little chocolate sauce.


But this was different. This was California and my first year at school in the big city. We stared unbelievingly at Lickity Split's spread. The woman behind the counter gave us a nice run-down of the store's offerings. All we wanted was a cup of vanilla and/or a cup of chocolate - or maybe even a little of both. But the woman started blurting out McConnell's ice cream flavors like the one's I've already mentioned, and more. Then she hit the frozen yogurt collection: non-fat Vanilla, Raspberry Truffle, Double Dutch Chocolate Fudge, non-fat Chocolate Mint and non-fat Kahlua, among others. Next was her array of health shakes with funky, hip, West Coast names like "Kamikaze," "Peanut Butter Booster," "Cocktail Cooler," "Mocha Rocha," "Spring Break" and my personal favorite, "Banana Wama."

Just then, Che nudged me in the ribs with his elbow just like he used to do in class right before he'd fake appendicitis so he could go home early - pointing to small receptacles full of fruit, nuts, chips and crumbled stuff. "Toppings," the lady behind the counter informed us. "They go on top of the ice cream and yogurt," she added. Then I noticed the Butterfinger topping, surrounded by others such as sliced almonds, granola, apple cobbler, banana chips, strawberries, boysen-


berries and gummy bears.


ants are supposed to do.





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## Edomasa-Miso Hungry!

Like most people, I haven't gotten much sleep lately. Worried about the frenetic rush of love and war, I lie awake at night and

More often than not, however, I think about sushi. Where some people count sheep, I count shrimp. I think about fresh salmon sushi, and how good that would taste really late in the evening.

Fortunately, Santa Barbara has a terrific late-night sushi bar that can satisfy my sushi-est urges until the wee hours of the morning. Edomasa, on De la Vina Street, is open until 12:30 in the morning on weeknights, and even later on the weekends.

But late night hours alone do not a good sushi bar make. The test is whether the sushi is fresh — in the case of Edomasa, if it were any fresher, it'd swim away.

When you first sit down at the sushi bar, the attentive Edomasa waitperson brings a steaming bowl of miso soup, which is a surefire appetizer. As they serve it, the broth is tart but not too salty, and the tofu isn't too firm.

My main man Massy, who was in charge of my sushi preparation on my late-night foray earlier this week, recommended what's rapidly becoming Edo-masa's specialty: their spicy rolls. My companions and I started off with the spicy tuna roll, which surrounds tuna sushi in a spicy/creamy hot sauce with strips of cucumber and a layer of perfectly cooked rice.

The nature of hotness is what differentiates Edomasa's spicy rolls from, let's say, a fish taco loaded with salsa. Salsa hits your palate from the start, in sparks of red-hot and blue. But a

spicy roll gets you from behind, quietly waiting until the other flavors have subsided for the hotness to register. I enjoyed the rolls so much I ordered three more.

A benchmark of Santa Barbara's sushi bars is the California roll, which is cooked crab meat rolled up with avocado and cucumber in a layer of rice, and once again, Massy and Edomasa know how to do it right. After one order, I wished they all could be California rolls.

The catch of the day var-

especially fresh. In my case, the halibut was recommended, and was quite good. Edomasa's halibut sushi is served with a healthy slice of the fish over rice, with a sprinkling of hot pepper and green onion and topped off with a sprinkle of rice vinegar. The combination of flavors can be at first unexpected, but once the taste hits, the halibut sushi is bound to be a favorite.

Sushi man Massy's boss, a gregarious guy named Ty, recognized me from my previous visits. "You're Haden ies, and it's a good idea to Guest, aren't you? I read ask your sushi chef what's your review in the Nexus!

You're a regular party animal!" Just then, fortunately, a party in the corner of the restaurant fired up the karaoke machine and proceeded to shout through "Great Balls of Fire." We laughed, ordered another round of spicy tuna roll, and managed to get home in time for Letterman's Top-Ten list, which is what I'd call a pretty fantastic late-night
