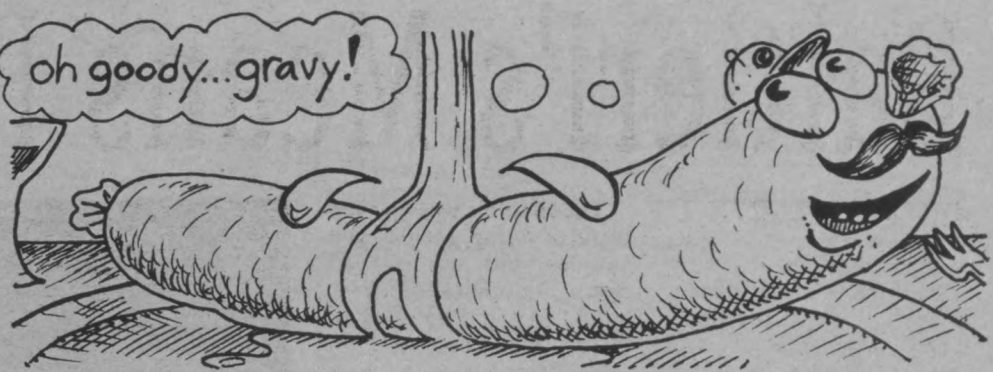

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

Then the Egghead is definitely the eatery for you.

Located upstairs from the New York Hero and Action Sports Arena, the Egghead offers casual ambiance and hearty grub for those on a meager budget. From the moment you pick up the

egg-shaped menu to the satisfying sound of your fork plinking down on an empty plate, you know the Egghead has done you right.

The Egghead's willingness to please was demonstrated when my friends and I held a surprise birthday party at 7:00 a.m. Not only did they welcome us, they extended their unfailing hospitality to a bevy of balloons, streamers, party hats and a cake.

Our eyes, still glazed from sleep, were gently opened from our bottomless cups of joe.
