





Gaucho Baseball To Receive Help; Seven New Recruits Sign to Team

The UCSB baseball team has completed its recruiting process for the 1999-2000 year by signing seven recruits. After finishing this season 27-26 overall and 14-16 in the Big West, the Gauchos will receive help with the catching, infield and pitching positions through the addition of

these new signees.

The Gauchos have signed catcher Taylor Vogt from Burlingame High School in Northern California. Vogt hit .529 with seven home runs and 32 RBIs during his senior year. Vogt was a preseason high-school All-American and was also named to the All-Northern California team, first team All-CCS and the Area Code team.

"[Vogt] is a big, strong, left-handed hitter that fits well into our ballpark," UCSB Head Coach Bob Brontsema said. "He brings great credentials to UCSB and could make an immediate impact."

In addition to Vogt, Santa Barbara has signed junior college transfer James Walker as catcher. Walker hit .330 with four homers and 32 RBIs for Monterey Peninsula Junior College and was named first team all-conference. Walker also threw out 43 of 58 runners from behind the plate.

"Walker is a great defensive catcher that should compete strongly for a major role," Brontsema said.

Santa Barbara will receive help in the infield with the acquisition of John Stephens from Foothill High School. While Stephens played first and third base in high school, he will probably see time in other infield positions.

"John is a versatile athlete that has the ability to play two or three positions," Brontsema said. "He is a good runner with power potential."

Stephens' prowess was evident in high school as he was named to second-team all-conference after hitting .536 with five homers, 42 ribbies, eight doubles and three triples.

To complement the Gaucho pitching staff, southpaw Rylie Ogle will transfer to Santa Barbara from Long Beach City College. Ogle went 5-2 with a 3.18 ERA while striking out 72 batters in 90 innings pitched.

"Ogle brings us an experienced left-handed pitcher," Brontsema said. I expect him to pitch many innings for us next year."

Brontsema also signed three right-handed hurlers in addition to Ogle. One of the righties is Jamie Gonzales from Porterville Junior College. Brontsema sees great improvement in Gonzales.

"Gonzales is a hardthrowing right-hander with a good slider," the sixth-year skipper said. "He is a converted shortstop that is relatively new to pitching that will continue to improve every day."

Gonzales was named to the second-team allconference last season at Porterville and had a 7-2 record with a 2.68 ERA while whiffing 70 batters in 78

Keith Kelly, from Walnut High School, will be joining Gonzales. Kelly went 7-3 with a 2.13 ERA and struck out 63 batters in 61 innings.

"Kelly is a 6'7" right-hander with loads of potential," Brontsema said. "He could be the sleeper of this recruiting class."

Rounding out the pitching recruits for Santa Barbara is Phil Galer.

"Galer is a strong righthander with a great changeup," Brontsema said of the Diablo Valley College transfer.


