In the Ad By H. Ahmed All True That he Said?

Editor, Daily Nexus:

I am writing this letter in response to the statements put forth by Hisham Ahmed in his half-page paid advertisement in the Nexus on Tuesday, May 24.

Contrary to what Mr. Ahmed claims occurred involving the writing and publishing of an article about Mr. Ahmed, Greg Apt never told Jay Hubbard to refrain from writing this article because its subject was "Palestinian and anti-Semitic." Mr. Ahmed goes on to state that the "slanderous, outrageous and defamatory remarks by Mr. Apt and their reinforcement by the 'unethical and unprofessional' pressures by Mr. Elzer on Mr. Hubbard, discouraging him from writing the article, need to be subjected to the proper administrative measures and public scrutiny." I find this remark to be "slanderous, outrageous and defamatory" in light of the fact that Mr. Ahmed never bothered to contact or question Mr. Apt to confirm these accusations and refused to speak with him about them after the publication of his advertisement.

It is arrogant on the part of Mr. Ahmed to expect to be able to monopolize the limited opinion space available in the Nexus with one issue. The questions that arise from the Palestinian/Israeli conflict are vitally important, but they are not the epicenter of the world. It would be disappointing if the public were to swallow Mr. Ahmed's statement that the "reason that the this issue (the publication of the article about himself) is significant is that it involves a case of discrimination based on national ethnic origin." Mr. Ahmed has had three articles published expounding his views and analysis of the occupation situation over the course of this year; that is more than anyone else can claim.

Mr. Ahmed, if you do, as you claim, represent the voice of the Palestinians, it is easy to answer the question that you pose in the statement, "one is compelled to raise the fundamental question as to why Palestinians are misperceived in and by the United States": Your behavior is the root of these misperceptions. It has been observed during forums held to rationally discuss the issue of Palestine that you demand recognition as an authority on the subject, and therefore the courtesy due such an

authority, without according it in return. The term discussion implies the examination and exchange of two or more opinions - this is made difficult by your insistence on phrasing your opinions as statements aimed at invoking an immediate and instinctive negative reaction from your audience, which inhibits any rational discussion. One would hope that you, as a candidate for a Ph.D. in the political science department, would have learned some of the basic skills of diplomacy that would facilitate a rational discussion of any subject. It is understood that this subject is very personal to you, but Dr. Hecht seems able to maintain his composure in the face of statements likening the Jews to the Nazis (probably the most offensive statement that you could make to a Jew). Maybe you would be able to produce some new thinking and understanding on this subject if you learned to discuss in place of haranguing.

Voter Research Messy But May Lead to Jesse

I want to express my appreciation of your excellent coverage of Jesse Jackson's recent visit to UCSB. Both the text and the photographs conveyed the spirit and the

content of Jackson's message.

I would also like to address the points raised by David Samson in his letter of May 26. It seems from his statements that Mr. Samson has not done much reading about Reverend Jackson's campaign. In fact, Jackson stands in contrast to the other candidates because he has specific proposals to back his stands. He has printed "issue briefs" which detail how he would deal with issues like AIDS, the defense budget, education and Central America. Have any of the other candidates done this?

Jesse Jackson is the only candidate who has spelled out a proposed budget. He has concrete ideas for negotiating a peace settlement in the Middle East, for a new policy in South Africa, for reversing the U.S. trade deficit, and for all of the major issues of this campaign. The Students for Jackson group on this campus held a forum (which Mr. Samson apparently missed) presenting his positions on these and other areas. We still have issue briefs at our table. The Los Angeles Times ran an in-depth interview with Reverend Jackson on May 27, which provides more information on his views.

Jackson is not so naive as to want to force engineers to work out of their areas of expertise. There are ample projects which are crying out for their skills and training; for example, "non-military development of outer space, joint ventures with the Soviets to Mars (or) a comprehensive Third World development plan." (Jesse Jackson, Los Angeles Times, May 27). Does Mr. Samson really believe that engineers can only be employed in defense research?

Reverend Jackson cannot be held responsible for Mr. Samson's assumptions about his positions. He has never advocated "donating grain to Latin American countries" as the means to redress the economic woes of the Third World. With all of the Jackson campaign's eminent economic advisers, I doubt that he needs a lecture from Professor Crouch.

In fact, it is Mr. Samson who is employing tired rhetoric with his depiction of Jackson as an "emotional preacher." Throughout the campaign this charge has been made to distract voter attention from the fact that Jackson offers specific solutions as well as high ideals. There is no reason we cannot have both in one candidate! Please investigate the candidates yourself and vote for the man with vision and substance — JESSE JACKSON.

Scheer's Music Review Gives Reader the Blues

After attending the Isla Vista BluesFest Tuesday, May 17, at the Graduate, four friends and I were happy to see the Blues arrive full force in I.V. Mr. Scheer's review left a little to be desired, however. He is correct when he states the Graduate is hardly reminiscent of the proverbial smoky barroom, but where in I.V. can we seat 500 people with that scenario? Despite the "bigness" of the Graduate, look at what we got for a \$15 ticket. When Johnny "Clyde" Copland took the stage shortly after 8 p.m. the show didn't stop until nearly six hours later. Instead of condemning the Graduate for its size, I think we should be thanking Graduated Productions for bringing in four quality acts while managing to keep tickets at a reasonable price.

Scheer mentions Copland and Lonnie Brooks selling out for Miller beer. With recent advances of the Blues comes this one drawback. I suggest forgetting about Copland singing one Miller tune and Brooks sarcastically hyping Genuine Draft and remember, despite their newfound popularity, they still remain as approachable as ever. I was fortunate enough to get in a few words with each performer and every one expressed enthusiasm at playing again in Santa Barbara, especially in an outdoor setting such as UCSB's Lagoon.

Scheer also criticized the event as a "shallowly, boisterous 'party." His opinion wasn't a popular one with the performers when one considers the fact that both Brooks and John Lee Hooker were disappointed when the crowd wasn't dancing and "boogying" as much as they would have liked. When these artists are up on stage, they want the crowd on their feet groovin' with them, not sitting on their rear ends. This interaction between performers and audience characterizes the Blues and was none more evident when Hooker called the crowd to its feet to boogie with him during his final tunes.

As for Scheer's actual review of the show, it was apparent he did little or no research. First, Hooker's set was unexpectedly short because a) he was expecting to start at 10:30 p.m., not 1 a.m. and b) he had an early flight out of Santa Barbara the following morning. Hooker expressed regret at only being able to play a short set, but was understanding when informed it was a first-time thing for the Graduate and promoters. Second, Hooker's "mystery woman" would be no mystery if Scheer had attended any of his recent performances at Oscar's in Santa Barbara. She has opened up for his past three shows while the band warms up for Hooker.

In all of Scheer's criticism not one word was mentioned about Charlie MusselWhite. An unexpected pleasure (I had very little knowledge of his music), MusselWhite and band had the Graduate crowd rocking. When I asked him about this afterward, he showed no sign of egoism whatsoever, just

that he was looking forward to returning soon. Very rare is it that a collection of music artists such as these show no sign of egoism or arrogance whatsoever. MusselWhite and the other three artists were class acts on and off the stage and had much to offer to enthusiastic fans.

In the past, the Santa Barbara Blues Society worked hard to get mainstream Blues acts. Securing these acts has been possible with the help of La Casa De La Raza, Oscar's and, more recently, the Lobero and Savoy Theaters along with the Graduate. Scheer's review indicates he would prefer that this "selling out" on the Blues stay away from Santa Barbara. I believe, however, the vast majority of people in attendance understood the need for advertising and simply chose to ignore it. Besides, what's a little extra money for the people who have certainly earned it?






